- 1 1. By Order dated May 1, 2013, the Court granted summary adjudication in Plaintiffs' favor  
2 on the First Cause of Action, subparagraphs 91(b) and (d), and the Sixth Cause of Action  
3 of the First Amended Verified Complaint. The remaining Causes of Action were  
4 dismissed with prejudice.
- 5 2. By Order dated MAY 6, 2013 and  
JULY 23, 2013, the Court also granted summary judgment in favor  
6 of Plaintiff-in-Intervention The Episcopal Church on its First Amended Complaint-in-  
7 Intervention and in favor of Cross-Defendants on the First Amended Cross-Complaint.
- 8 3. This Judgment, together with the aforementioned dismissals, fully resolves and  
9 adjudicates all claims and issues among and between all parties.

10 THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that final Judgment is  
11 entered in favor of Plaintiffs (Jane Hyde Rasmussen; The Protestant Episcopal Church in The  
12 Diocese of Los Angeles; and The Right Rev. J. Jon Bruno, Bishop Diocesan of The Episcopal  
13 Diocese of Los Angeles), Cross-Defendants (The Protestant Episcopal Church in the Diocese of  
14 Los Angeles and The Bishop of the Protestant Episcopal Church in Los Angeles) and Plaintiff-  
15 in-Intervention The Episcopal Church and against Defendants (The Rector, Wardens and  
16 Vestrymen of St. James Parish in Newport Beach, California; The Rev. Praveen Bunyan; James  
17 Dale; Barbara Hettinga; Paul Stanley; Cal Trent; John McLaughlin; Penny Reveley; Mike  
18 Thompson; Jill Austin; Eric Evans; Frank Daniels; Cobb Grantham; and Julia Houten) and  
19 Cross-Complainant (The Rector, Wardens and Vestrymen of St. James Parish in Newport Beach,  
20 California) in accordance with the Court's Orders referenced in paragraphs 1 and 2 above. Costs  
21 are awarded to Plaintiffs, Cross-Defendants and Plaintiff-in-Intervention.
