

RESOLUTION #6

TO: The 193rd Convention of the Episcopal Diocese of Kentucky
FROM: The Task Force on Racial Reconciliation and the Justice and Jubilee department
SUBJECT: Anne Braden commemoration.

Resolved, That this 193rd Convention of the Episcopal Diocese of Kentucky commits to continuing an Anne Braden commemoration each year near her birthdate (July 28) or the date of her death (March 6) on as a diocese in 2021, 2022, 2023, 2024; and be it further

Resolved, That this 193rd Convention of the Episcopal Diocese of Kentucky invites congregations to also hold their own commemorations in 2021, 2022, 2023, and 2024.

Explanation

The Episcopal Diocese of Kentucky held a meaningful Anne Braden commemoration in 2020 that took place at St. George's Episcopal Church: where Anne Braden attended church.

The Bishop's Advisory Committee on Liturgy and Music created a collect and suggested readings, and the Racial Reconciliation Task Force wrote a biographical sketch of Anne Braden that was distributed to the Diocese for local commemorations in congregations. The Racial Reconciliation Task Force urges the Episcopal Diocese of Kentucky to continue this commemoration for the next four years.
