

C.R.E.A.T.E Confirmation Curriculum

I had the privilege of working with Jenifer Gamber (author of [My Faith, My Life](#)), Sharon Pearson, and Jamie Martin-Currie developing a hybrid confirmation curriculum using both Jenifer's book and The Way of Love.

The curriculum is entitled C.R.E.A.T.E which stands for connect, read, experience, act, take my turn, and engage. There are 10 modules of hybrid learning. Each module has assignments youth work through on their own as well as interacting on the learning platform with others. The modules will then end with an engage component which will be "live" (zoom at this time). We are piloting the program this spring with 4 parishes and 4 Dioceses. The Diocese of Kentucky is one of the pilot Diocese.

At this time there is no cost for the program.

We have a group starting soon. Please let me know if you're interested in hearing more or would like to join.

While we do not yet know when Bishop White will be able to make visitations and confirm, this is a means of being prepared when that happens.
