

How you can help:

First, and most importantly, we are asking everyone to pray for peace in Myanmar and for all refugees.

Your financial donations are also welcome. St. Peter's Episcopal Church in Louisville has many members who are Karen refugees from Myanmar, and they are able to send money directly to those who need it. Every penny donated will go directly to informal Karen assistance organizations within the refugee camps and, as much as conditions permit, into Myanmar itself. Please note that it is often impossible to send money into Myanmar since the government has imposed strict controls on internet access (including transfers of money) and on external communications. The situation is often too dangerous to cross the border into Myanmar.
