A brief biographical essay "Telling My Story" about your background, where you grew up, where you live now and challenges that you face in pursuing your educational goals. (Limit: 350 words, or 1 page, size 12 type, double-spaced)

Summary/Description of the Academic program in which you are enrolled, your progress to date, and your goals and plans for the future (Limit: 200 words)

A current certified transcript of your academic progress

A letter of recommendation, preferably on letterhead, from a parish priest, campus minister, University professor, or community elder who can attest to your status and success as a non-traditional student.
