



### ALL SAINTS, TARPON SPRINGS

The Pack-a-Snack program provides more than 2,200 snacks to students on a weekly basis in Pinellas and Pasco Counties. The project supports chronically hungry students who receive free breakfast and lunch on school days but are food insufficient on the weekend.



### CHURCH OF THE EPIPHANY, CAPE CORAL

The Christmas Youth Gift Bag Ministry brings holiday cheer to children in Latino congregations in small underserved Episcopal churches in Arcadia, Myakka, Immokalee, and Sarasota during Christmas to share the “Good News” of Jesus Christ.

### HOLY INNOCENTS', VALRICO

Working in partnership with Dover Elementary School Food Pantry, Holy Innocents' will provide shelving and storage capacity in the school's food pantry and replace old shelving that is no longer adequate, allowing for 30% additional food storage.


### HOLY TRINITY, CLEARWATER

The monthly Laundry Love program offers more than just free laundry services, it provides God's love and care to a community of people who have become invisible in today's society.



### ST. ALBAN'S, ST. PETE BEACH

The CASA Meals program provides nutritious and delicious meals to women and children at CASA house in St. Petersburg. The A Hand Up program provides goods to young adults who are aging out of the Carlton Manor group homes. These programs alleviate the burden of food insecurity, and promote the physical and emotional well-being of those in need.



### ST. FRANCIS, TAMPA

The St. Francis HOPE program purpose is to share their faith as they serve people seeking United States citizenship. Classes are provided in Spanish and English for those seeking guidance to help prepare for citizenship testing, administered by the USCIS.



### ST. GEORGE'S, BRADENTON

They've Got a Good Thing Growing! The Plant a Pail program teaches community members of all ages how to plant their own vegetables as a sustainable food source in 5-gallon containers and earth boxes. Volunteers also educate on food production at home as food prices increase and food pantries supplies decrease in the community.

### ST. JOHN'S, BROOKSVILLE

The Angels' Wings Program provides essential items for children to stay warm, comfortable, and healthy during the colder months. The program fills a need that may not be covered by other resources and ensures that the children and families who are involved in early Head Start programs are able to survive and thrive, regardless of their financial situation or other circumstances.

### ST. JAMES HOUSE OF PRAYER, TAMPA

The longstanding Cornerstone Kids agency provides a free after-school program that includes tutoring, community mentoring, and a daily meal helping meet the physical, academic, and emotional needs of students in the area.

### ST. JOHN'S, PINE ISLAND

Beacon Bites Meal Delivery Program supplements the local Meals on Wheels service by providing meals to seniors, disabled and housebound persons in the area in conjunction with parish nurse visits. The program delivers meals to up to 25 people six days a week.

### ST. MARGARET OF SCOTLAND, SARASOTA

The Crafters for Hope initiative knits and sews handcrafted gifts and fills totebags that are given to cancer patients. The bags include port protectors, flannel drain bag sleeves, under arm pillows, and seatbelt covers to protect surgical areas.

### ST. MARK'S, MARCO ISLAND

The Our Daily Bread Food Pantry, open daily, serves more than 13,000 people each month. In 2020 it donated more than 1,150,000 lbs of non-perishable food, fresh produce, frozen meat, eggs, milk, dairy products, personal hygiene items, and toilet paper.

### ST. PAUL'S, NAPLES

Modeled after the St. Mark's Laundry Love Project on Marco Island, this ministry outreach also offsets laundry service expenses for marginalized Naples Manor residents and other underserved residents in need.

### ST. PETER'S, PLANT CITY

Friends in the Park is a coalition of churches and community organizations that provide a daily meal to local at-risk community members in partnership with the Plant City Recreation Department.

### ST. VINCENT'S, ST. PETERSBURG

Community Connections outreach project is a powerful initiative that leverages the resources of St. Vincent's community center to support the working poor and at-risk community of South St. Pete. The project is centered around providing a safe, welcoming space for individuals to gather, learn, form community, and receive free meals. Each month a different agency will be invited to make a presentation to the outside community followed by a free lunch. The Florida Department of Health in Pinellas County, in partnership with numerous agencies and non-profits, will also provide mental health access, health care, rental assistance, job placement and, other services at Community Connections.

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
