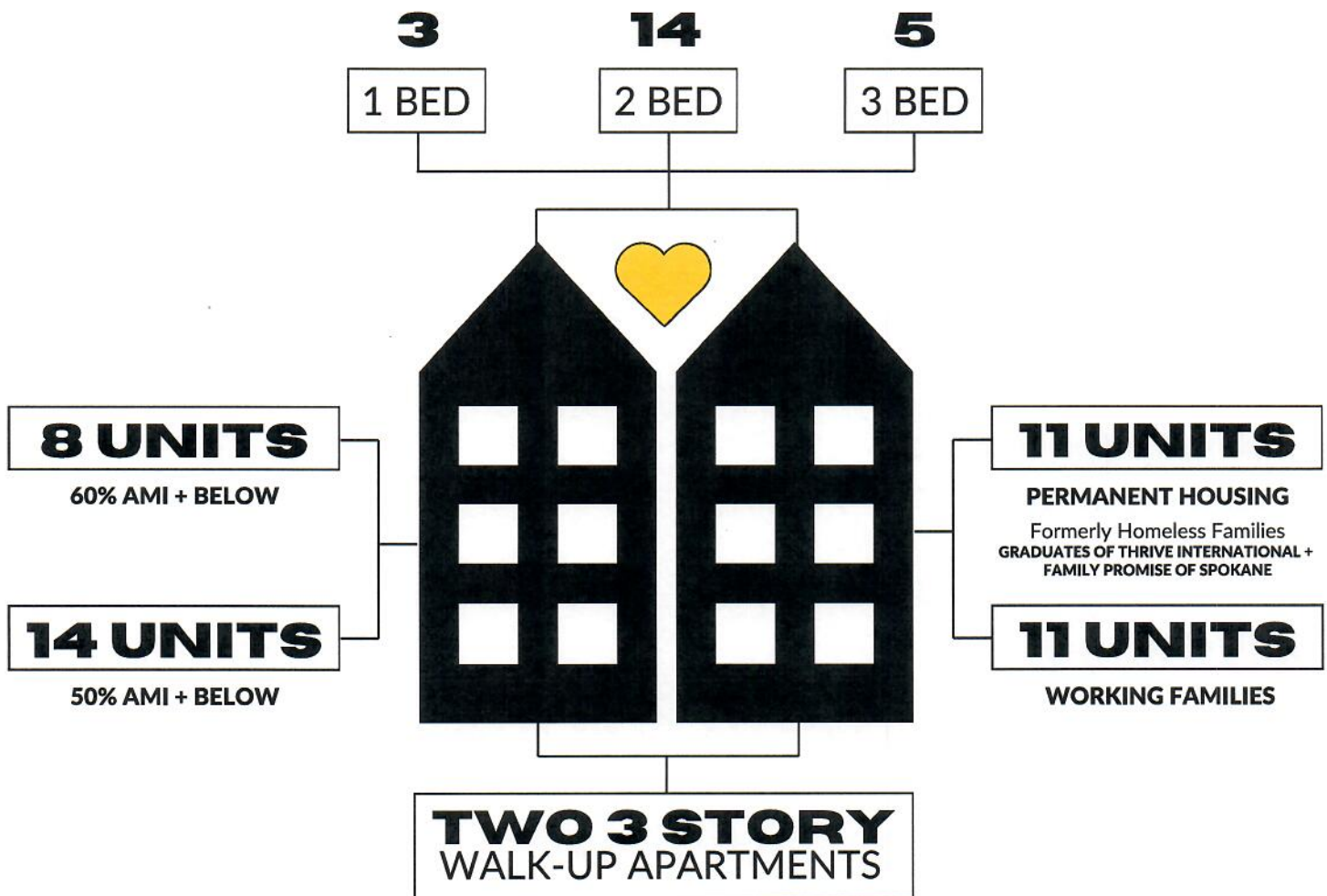


PROJECT MISSION STATEMENT

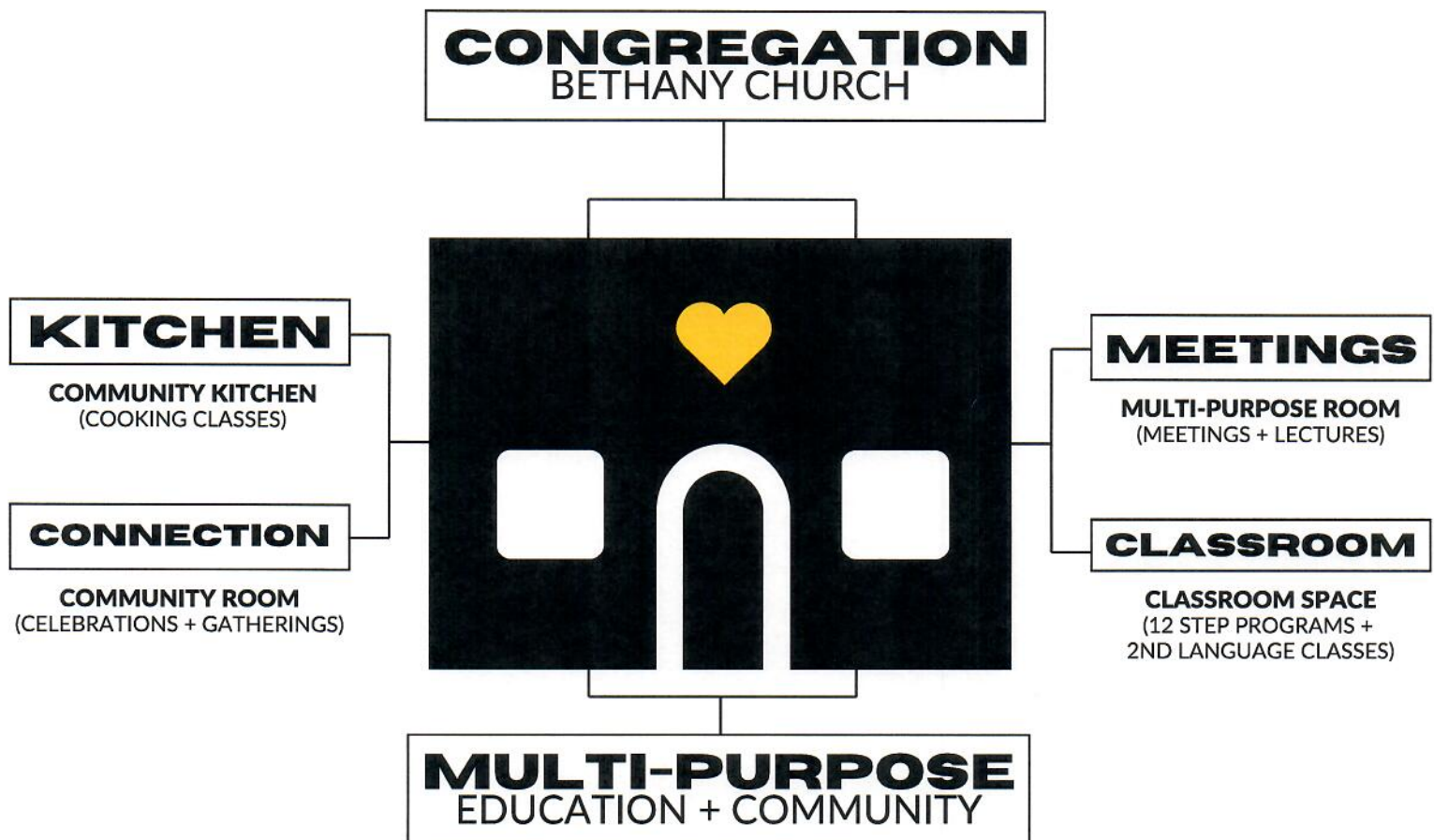


HOME FOR FAMILIES

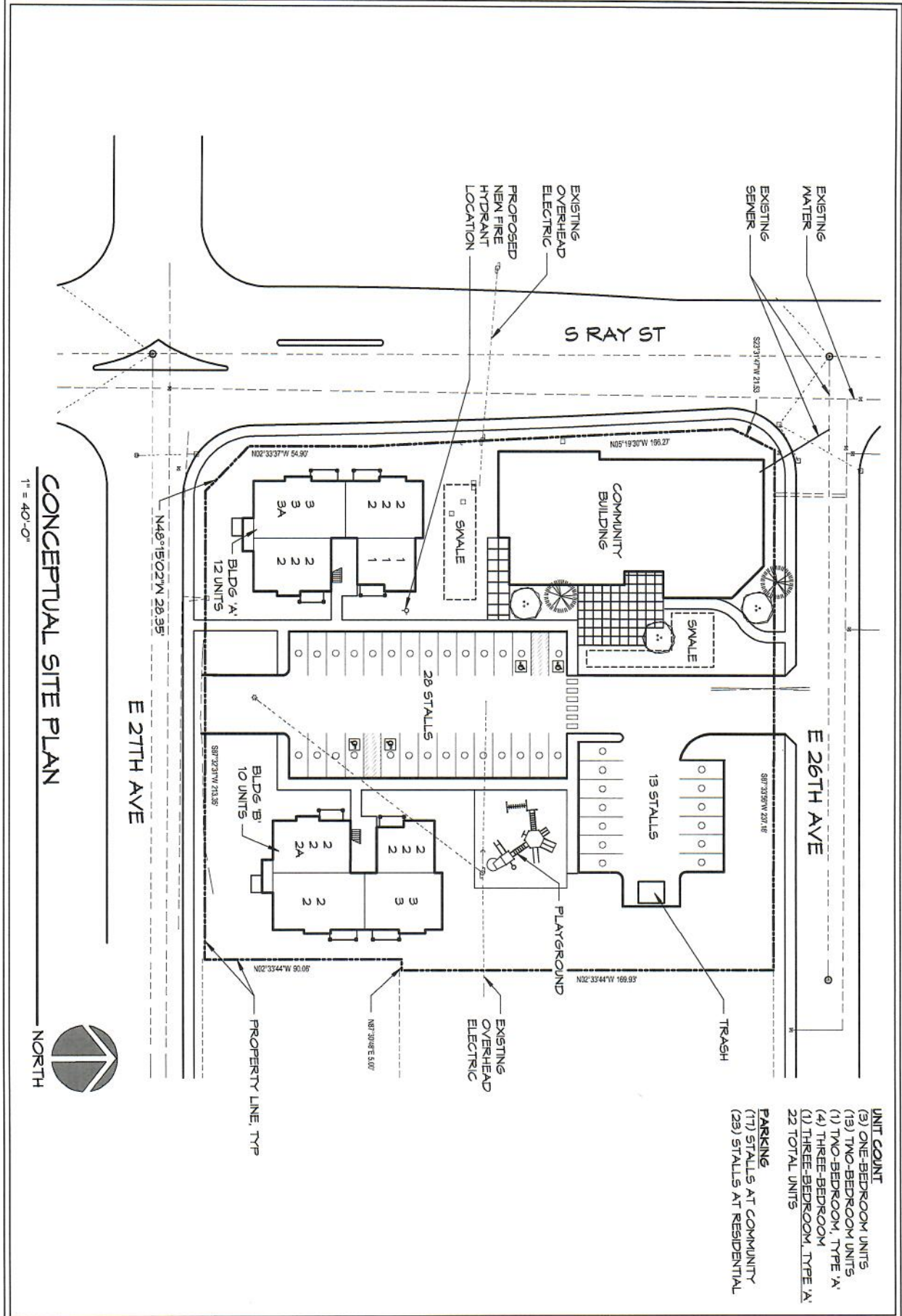

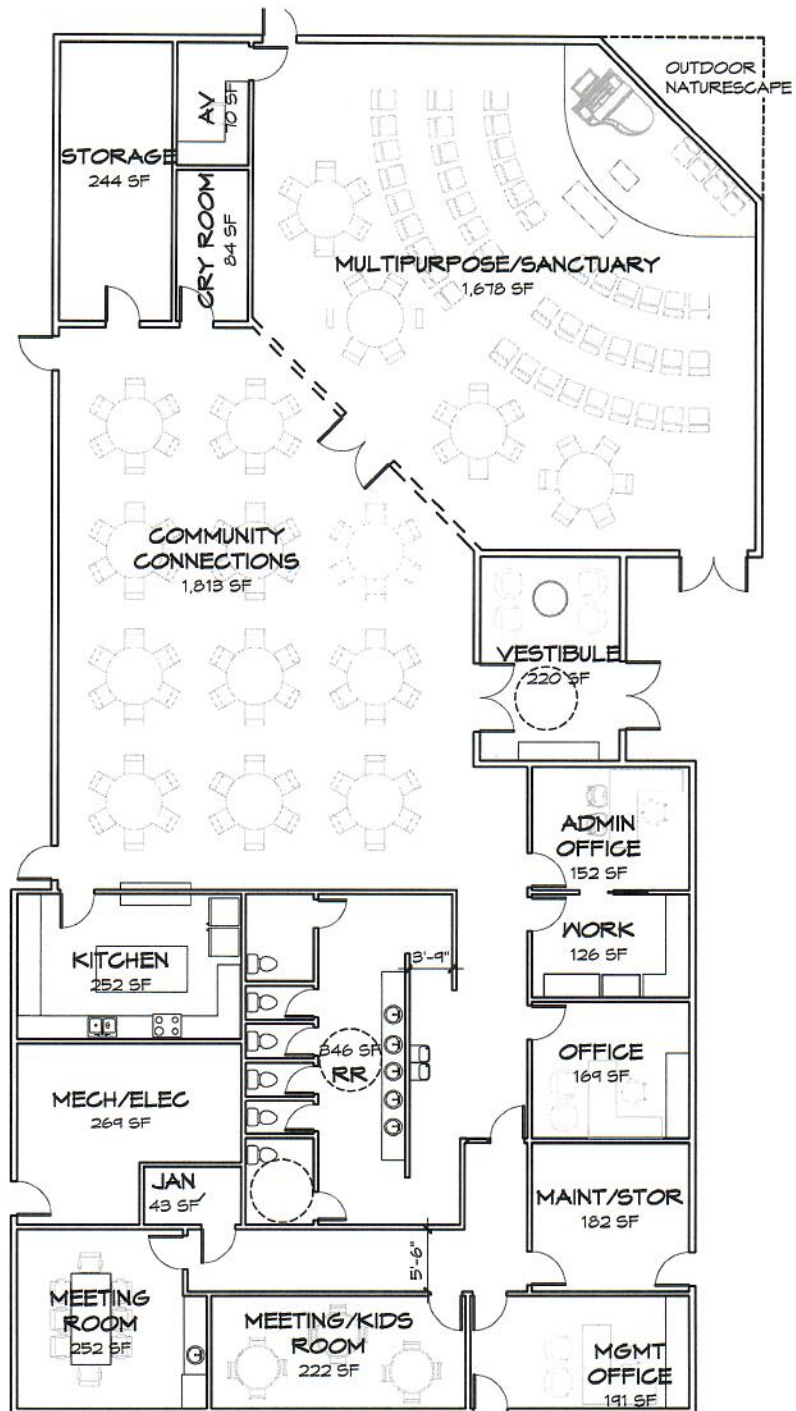

FUNDING STATUS

PROCLAIM LIBERTY HAS ALREADY MADE GREAT PROGRESS TOWARDS FUNDING

- Bethany Presbyterian Church has pledged a minimum of \$600,000 in insurance proceeds.
- The City of Spokane has already awarded over \$2 Million in HOME Funds.
- Proclaim Liberty will mortgage what the property can safely support (estimated at \$2.97 Million).
- We are finalists for a \$3 Million FHLB request (Announcement in late December).
- A Commerce Housing Trust Fund application has been made (Announcement in December).

And yet a funding gap still remains before we can begin the construction of this project.
