What is the overall timeframe?

The criteria includes:

- Must be in the cold food and beverage space. Companies can ALSO be in other categories, but for the sake of this award, *Food Logistics* is only concerned with the cold food and beverage side of the business. Companies only in the non-food and beverage and shelf-stable space will be disqualified.
- **Who is eligible?** Executives, operators, managers, truck drivers and more. If this nominee works in the cold food and beverage supply chain, he/she is eligible.
- Applications are free; there is no charge/fee to apply.
- Nominees can be located nationally and/or internationally.
- Application must be completed in full to be considered. Incomplete submissions or those with incorrect information will be disqualified.
- All applications must be submitted electronically.
- *Food Logistics* will not be held responsible for publishing names or other information that were incorrectly submitted in the nomination process.
- Information provided in the application may be used in print and online.
- Limit up to three nominations per company.
- Nominees representing PR/marketing firms/agencies are not applicable. However, nominations can come from suppliers, vendors, customers, co-workers, PR/marketing firms and/or the companies themselves. Companies can self-nominate. PR/marketing firms can nominate one or more client.
- Honorees are vetted by *Food Logistics*' editorial staff.
- Previous wins do not automatically guarantee a spot in this year's award.
- Multiple applications do not guarantee a win.
- Proprietary information may not be included.
