- Must be in the landscape industry. Companies can be in multiple categories, such as lawn care, irrigation, lighting, hardscapes, etc., but must also be in the landscape industry, either residential, commercial, or both, in order to qualify for this award.
- **Who is eligible?** Female executives, operators, managers, contractors and more. If this nominee works in the landscape industry, she is eligible.
- Applications are free; there is no charge/fee to apply.
- Nominees can be located nationally and/or internationally.
- Application must be completed in full to be considered. Incomplete submissions or those with incorrect information will be disqualified.
- All applications must be submitted electronically.
- *Green Industry Pros* will not be held responsible for publishing names or other information that were incorrectly submitted in the nomination process.
- Information provided in the application may be used online.
- Limit up to three nominations per company.
- Nominees representing PR/marketing firms/agencies are not applicable. However, nominations can come from suppliers, vendors, customers, co-workers, PR/marketing firms and/or the companies themselves. Companies can self-nominate. PR/marketing firms can nominate one or more client.
