Criteria:

- *Supply & Demand Chain Executive's* audience does not cover food/beverage supply chains, therefore companies and projects must be in the non-food and beverage space. Companies CAN be in multiple categories, including food and beverage, but for the purpose of this award, we're only concerned with the non-food sector (think automotive, e-commerce, retail, pharmaceutical, etc.).
- Nominees and projects can be located nationwide and/or international.
- Applications are free; there is no charge/fee to apply.
- Application must be completed in full to be considered. Incomplete submissions or those with incorrect information will be disqualified.
- Be sure to hit "Submit" at the end of the application process.
- All applications must be submitted electronically. Applications emailed to *Supply & Demand Chain Executive's* staff or submitted through social media channels will not be eligible.
- Some information provided in the application may be used online.
- Limit up to one nomination per company/project.
- Nominations can come from suppliers, vendors, customers, co-workers, PR/marketing firms and/or the companies themselves.

- If you don't want a vendor/customer's name included due to proprietary reasons, that's okay. Feel free to use descriptors, such as a large pharmaceutical company or a global 3PL. Please note, if you DO include the company's name, it will be included online.
- Honorees are vetted by *Supply & Demand Chain Executive's* editorial staff.
- Previous wins do not automatically guarantee a spot in this year's award. Wins from other awards not related to *Supply & Demand Chain Executive* will also not automatically guarantee a spot in this year's award.
