## The criteria includes:

- *Food Logistics* reaches executives in the cold food and beverage sector (growers, producers, manufacturers, wholesalers, packagers, and grocers) and the logistics sector (transportation, warehousing, distribution, software, and technology). If your company or your customers are a part of our reach, then you are eligible. Companies not part of these sectors or do not have customers in these sectors are not eligible. - **Who is eligible?** Executives in the cold food and beverage sector (growers, producers, manufacturers, wholesalers, packagers, and grocers) and the logistics sector (transportation, warehousing, distribution, software and technology).
- Applications are free; there is no charge/fee to apply.
- Nominees can be located nationally and/or internationally.
- Be sure to hit "Submit" at the end of the application process. Applications must be completed in full to be considered. Incomplete submissions or those with incorrect information will be disqualified.
- All applications must be submitted electronically. Applications emailed to *Food Logistics'* staff or submitted through social media channels will not be eligible.
- *Food Logistics* will not be held responsible for publishing names or other information that was incorrectly submitted in the nomination process. Please proofread your work.
- Information provided in the application may be used in print and online.
- Limit up to three nominations per company.
- Nominations can come from PR/marketing firms/agencies, suppliers, vendors, customers, co-workers and/or the companies themselves. Executives can self-nominate. PR/marketing firms can nominate one or more client. Nominees from PR/marketing firms/agencies are not applicable.
- Honorees are vetted by *Food Logistics'* editorial staff.
- Previous wins do not automatically guarantee a spot in this year's award. Wins from other awards not related to *Food Logistics* will also not automatically guarantee a spot in this year's award.
- Multiple applications do not guarantee a win.
