Disability:IN empowers business to achieve disability inclusion and equality. The Disability:IN Mentorship Exchange is a six-month career mentoring opportunity for college students and recent graduates with disabilities, including veterans, whom we call NextGen Leaders.

All mentor/mentee relationships are unique but common experiences include resume help, development of an elevator pitch, and self-disclosure during interviews. Our mentors remark that not only did their mentees gain invaluable insight, but they did as well.

Approximately 85% of NextGen Leaders participating in the Mentorship Exchange have gained employment since the program's inception.
