FACTUAL BASIS & LEGAL ARGUMENT

Factual Basis

This protest concerns three Unaffiliated voters in Rockingham County—Russell Lee Collins, John Phillip Murphy, and Michael Aaron Baker—who appeared to vote in the March 2026 primary, initially selected a Democratic ballot, and then later changed their minds and requested a Republican ballot. Each voter was permitted to cast a provisional Republican ballot, and those votes were counted in the Republican primary.

The official Authorization-to-Vote (“ATV”) records reflect that each of the three voters is registered as Unaffiliated and, at check-in, selected a Democratic ballot. The election official issued each voter an ATV reflecting the Democratic ballot selection. After that point, each voter requested a Republican ballot instead. Election officials cancelled the Democratic ATV and issued the voter a provisional Republican ballot, which the voter cast and which was later counted. *See* Exhibit A (ATV records and provisional records for each voter).

The cancelled Democratic ATVs and the associated provisional Republican records establish that, for each of the three voters, the voter’s official ballot selection for the election transaction was Democratic, but the voter ultimately cast and had counted a Republican ballot via the provisional process.

Legal Argument

Unaffiliated voters are entitled to participate in a party primary only by selecting one party’s ballot for that election. NCGS § 163-119; NCGS § 163-166.7(a). That selection is reflected in the voter’s Authorization-to-Vote and governs which party primary the voter may participate in for that election transaction.

Here, the official ATV records show that each voter selected a Democratic ballot and executed an ATV reflecting that choice. *See* Exhibit A. Election officials then cancelled those Democratic ATVs and issued provisional Republican ballots, which were counted in Republican primary contests. *See* Exhibit A. This procedure effectively allowed the voters to cast votes in Republican primary contests notwithstanding their initial Democratic ballot selection documented in the official ATV.

Provisional voting exists as a fail-safe when eligibility cannot be confirmed at the voting site, not as a mechanism to allow a voter to switch party primaries after executing an ATV and receiving a ballot. *See* NCGS § 163-166.11. The “act of voting” rule further underscores why party-ballot switching must be handled through controlled procedures rather than ad hoc conversion to a provisional ballot. 08 NCAC 10B.0104. Allowing these votes to count in the Republican primary undermines the integrity of the party-ballot selection process and results in illegal votes being counted in Republican primary contests.

Accordingly, the Board should sustain this protest and order that the three provisional Republican ballots issued under these circumstances be disapproved and removed from the Republican primary totals for any affected contests (including the SD26 Republican primary, if applicable). The Board should further require preservation and production of the cancelled Democratic ATVs and related records for these voters so that the official record reflects the voters’ initial party-ballot selections and the manner in which the provisional Republican ballots were issued and counted. NCGS § 163-119; NCGS § 163-166.7(a); NCGS § 163-166.11; 08 NCAC 10B .0104.

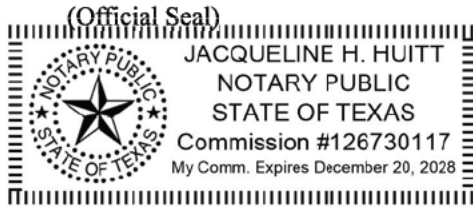
