PLAINTIFFS' AND STATE BOARD  
OF ELECTIONS DEFENDANTS'  
JOINT STIPULATION OF  
DISMISSAL WITH PREJUDICE

Plaintiffs and Defendants North Carolina State Board of Elections, Francis X. DeLuca, Stacy "Four" Eggers, IV, Sam Hayes, Robert Rucho, Jeff Carmon, and Siobham O'Duffy Millen hereby stipulate and agree to 1) a dismissal WITH PREJUDICE of State Board of Elections Defendants pursuant to Rule 41(a)(1)(ii) of the North Carolina Rules of Civil Procedure and 2) as follows:

1. The North Carolina State Board of Elections is not authorized to allow any form of electronic identification to satisfy North Carolina voter photo identification requirement found in N.C.G.S. § 163-166.16 and § 163-230.1 other than photo identification that satisfies all of the conditions found in § 163-166.16(a), unless and until the North Carolina General Assembly duly enacts a law that has the effect of permitting electronic identification

to satisfy the voter photo identification requirement, where such electronic identification is not already permitted by law to satisfy the requirement. The North Carolina State Board of Elections shall not promulgate any rule or numbered memorandum that purports to allow any electronic identification in violation of the foregoing sentence.

2. Based on and in reliance upon this Joint Stipulation and specifically the foregoing paragraph, Plaintiffs satisfied their claims and stipulate to dismissal. The parties shall bear their own costs and attorneys' fees.

This action is hereby dismissed with prejudice.
