Old Business

Discussion and/or Approval of Gilbert Park OSLAD Grant Proposal Director Bechtold gave an update on the OSLAD process and questions the Board had from the last board meeting. The first question entailed pulling out of the OSLAD application process early instead of pulling out after submission which would result in being blacklisted for two years. IDNR did state anytime you withdraw an application you are blacklisted for two years. Staff recommended strongly against pulling out of the OSLAD Grant Application or any grant process at any time.

Director Bechtold informed the Board that we did inquire with residents at our community input meeting whether they thought the district should pursue the OSLAD Grant per the Board's request. Director Bechtold shared that most

participants felt we should apply for the OSLAD Grant. She also shared that Governor Pritzker is recommending sweeping OSLAD funds next year (2025) which would reduce the amount available, reducing our odds next year. Director Bechtold also said with the \$250K commitment from Senator Porfirio we would not have to push back as many projects as we discussed last month. Director Bechtold stressed that if we do not go for a referendum or receive the referendum, we would need the added funding even more.

Commissioner Posey made a motion to approve the Gilbert OSLAD Grant Application Proposal from Wight & Company. It was seconded by Commissioner Vear and passed unanimously by roll call vote.

Discussion and/or Approval of Stone Park Plan Proposals

Director Bechtold informed the Board of the survey results for the Stone Park Plan proposal presented in the board packet. The winning proposal was Burkes Park plan. Director Bechtold informed the Board that there are five ADA components within the proposal. Bechtold explained this was a Sourcewell Agreement and would not require a bid.

Discussion took place about using different vendors for all our parks in the future. There was also discussion about whether the capital funds pledged by Senator Porfirio need to be used for Stone. Staff informed the Board that it is our understanding the \$250K can be used on capital improvement projects of the district's choice.

Director Bechtold asked for a motion to approve the Sourcewell Awarded Contract, Play Illinois through Burke for \$168,897.57 with the added \$6,102.43 in the budget as contingency. It was so moved by Commissioner Posey, seconded by Commissioner Vear and passed unanimously by roll call vote.

Park District of La Grange June 2024 Board Report Jennifer Bechtold, CPRP Executive Director

- As we continue with the 2024 Park Plan Proposal, the Citizen Task Force concluded its final meeting on May 22, 2024. Beyond Your Base will present the outcomes of our collective survey efforts at our next board meeting. Additionally, Wight & Company and Chapman & Cutler will provide details on the plans and bond parameters.
- The agreement for the Stone Park Renovation has been submitted. Anticipated renovations are slated to commence during the week of August 26, 2024, with the projected opening of the playground by late September. It is important to note that the proposed timeline is contingent upon weather conditions, and potential delays may arise in the event of inclement weather.
- Progress on the parking lot project continues as we near its completion. Landscaping was installed during the week of May 27th, enhancing the aesthetic appeal and functionality of the area. Presently, our focus is directed towards completing the punch list.
- We continue to meet with Wight & Company for the Waiola project (OSLAD Grant). The tentative schedule is as follows:
 - Design Development May to June
 - o Construction Documents June to August
 - o MWRD & Village Permitting August to October
 - o Bidding October to November
 - o Award Contract November
 - o Construction April to July
- We had a kickoff meeting for the Gilbert OSLAD grant on Thursday, June 6th. The application is due mid-September.

Athletics

- Summer athletic classes are in full swing. Between the weeks of April 29th and June 3rd, we have had 36 of 53 classes offered successfully run for a 68% success rate to begin the summer season.
- Kevin Miller and Liam Sise have been planning out the 24/25 La Grange Lions Travel Basketball Season. There will some significant changes to the program as we will be returning to having parent volunteers coach teams with hired coaches running skills practices during the week. Additionally, Dom Adjournani is working with the Personal Training staff to implement weekly 1-hour team trainings that focus on strength and agility that all teams will participate in. Tryouts for the La Grange Lions Basketball teams will take place between August 17th and August 22nd for 4th through 8th grade boys and girls teams.

Fitness

- La Grange Fitness had 135 new members join during the month of May 2024. We currently have 2,572 members through May 31st, 2024, compared to 2,355 as of May 31st, 2023 (an increase of 217 members). During the month of May, we had 35 cancelation requests (Compared to 59 in 2023), 3 members requested a hold. We also had 3 annual memberships expired, 9 renewed, and 2 transferred to monthly memberships.
- The month of May brought in 2,182 group fitness participants. Throughout the month of May 2024, the group fitness classes had an average of 436 participants per week and an average of 14 participants per class.
- We had 9,714 visits by fitness members, during the month of May 2024, compared to 8,754 during May 2023, an increase of 960 visits. We had 56 guest visits bringing in \$560 in revenue.

- The personal training department brought \$4,665 for May 2024 compared to \$6,135 in May 2023 (a decrease of \$1,470). We had 121 personal training sessions during the month of May 2024 compared to 114 sessions in May 2023. May was our trainer, Evan Gonzalez's last month with La Grange Fitness. The decrease in personal training sales is due to his clients not re-upping sessions. We are currently seeking to hire1-2 new personal trainers to join our team.
- Throughout the month of May, we offered our student special: \$60 for a 60-day membership and \$90 for a 90-day membership. We sold 62 student specials (20 60-day & 42 90-day) bringing in \$4,980 in revenue. We will continue to offer our student special throughout the month of June and are hoping to keep the momentum going.

Special Events

- The first ever Garage Sale Event was held on May 4th. The event was a success with 100+ people in attendance. We had 13 participants sell items at the Garage Sale.
- Touch a Truck was on May 11th and was an enormous success. We had over 1,000+ people show up for the event. We had 9 total vehicles at the event.









- Athletic operations are in full swing. Most of the parks are utilized every day for either soccer, softball, or baseball. Staff continue to mow the turf playing surfaces and prepare the baseball fields for practices and scheduled games.
- Henry Gale completed his Eagles Scout project at the Community Center on May 11th. Henry and his team did an amazing job at planting and amending the northside of the building. Parks staff irrigates the new plating weekly and will continue to monitor the new perennial bed. We wanted to include before and after pictures because Henry did such a great job.







- Grounds and trash staff continue to keep the parks clean and safe. The weather continues to be ideal for healthy grass and plants. The weather also has been great for the public to utilize the parks more. So, more effort has been put into grounds maintenance and trash removal in daily operations.

Background:

Implications:

The Resolution permits closed executive session minutes eighteen (18) months prior to the date of the Resolution to be released and available, and that good cause exists to maintain as confidential those minutes of the closed executive session meetings that have occurred within the 18 months prior to the date of this Resolution. It also permits the destruction of verbatim audio recordings of the closed executive session portion of the meetings, for those recordings for which at least eighteen (18) months and one (1) day have passed since the date of the recording per the Open Meetings Act.

WHEREAS, the Park District of LaGrange Board of Commissioners have met from time to time in executive session for purposes authorized by, and in conformity with, the Illinois Open Meetings Act, 5 ILCS 120/1.01, et seq.;

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners has kept written minutes and verbatim audio recordings of all such executive sessions in accordance with the Open Meetings Act;

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners have undertaken their semiannual review of executive session minutes as to content and by this enactment hereby determine that all minutes of executive sessions held more than 18 months prior to the date of this Resolution should be released and available and that good cause exists to maintain, as confidential, those minutes of executive session meetings that have occurred within the 18 months prior to the date of this Resolution; and

WHEREAS, as to the verbatim audio recordings of the closed session portion of the meetings, for those recordings for which at least eighteen (18) months and 1 day have passed since the date of recording, the Board of Commissioners hereby finds and determines that destruction of the verbatim

audio recordings of the identified closed sessions is in accordance with the requirements of the Open Meetings Act and hereby approve and direct such destruction in accordance with Section 2.06(c) of the Act and, further, ratifies all prior acts concerning all such tapes that are older than 18 months and not otherwise subject to court order.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the President and Board of Commissioners of the Park District of LaGrange as follows:

SECTION 1. RECITALS.

That the foregoing recitals shall be and are hereby incorporated into and made a part of this Resolution as if fully set forth in this Section 1.

The Executive Director is hereby authorized and directed to maintain the minutes from all other executive session meetings for which release has not yet been approved in a confidential matter in order to protect the public interest and the privacy of individuals.

SECTION 3. DESTRUCTION OF CERTAIN VERBATIM AUDIO RECORDINGS.

The Executive Director is hereby authorized and directed to destroy forthwith

all verbatim audio recordings of closed session meetings of the Park District of La Grange which took place on or prior to December 9, 2022.

SECTION 4.RESOLUTION OF CONFLICTS.

All resolutions or ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 5.SAVING CLAUSE.

If any section, paragraph, clause, or provision of this Resolution shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any of the other provisions of this Resolution, which are hereby declared to be separable.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.

Background:

The Board Policy Manual has been adopted by the Park District of La Grange Board of Commissioners and requires frequent updating, due to changes in operations, as well as legal updates.

Implications:

As staff and legal continue to review the Board Policy Manual, we have two updated policies to present to the Board.

Section 234: Personal Days: Changed to Personal Leave

234.1 Full-Time Employees language changed to personal leave verses personal days. 234.2 Permanent Part Time I Employees (IMRF Status) will earn 1 hour of personal leave for every 40 worked hours effective August 1, 2024. The following paraments apply to the updated policy:

- Eligible to use their personal leave either 90 days after August 1, 2024, or 90 days after commencing employment, whichever is later
- Employees presently accruing sick and personal days may use immediately and are not subject to the 90-day waiting period
- Accrue a maximum of 40 hours annually
- Carry over a maximum of 40 hours unused paid leave annually
- Requests must be submitted a minimum of seven days in advance
- Personal leave must be taken in a minimum of 2-hour increments
- Unused personal leave is not paid out upon separation
- All current personal day from January 1, 2024, through July 31, 2024, accrued shall be converted to personal leave

Section 242: Sick Leave

Section 242.2.2 Sick leave for Permanent Part-Time I Employees will fall under personal leave effective August 1, 2024. Any accrued sick leave will be transferred to personal leave and sick leave will be discontinued.

Staff Recommendation:

Staff recommend approving Policy Section 236 and Section 242 as presented.
