President Penicook stated the new chairs are not in the budget for this year. The Board will discuss this in April and the new budget would be approved in May.

Superintendant of Facilities Chris Finn stated he is working on the internet for the Community Center. He added the Village owns the building, not the Park District.

Board Comments

Commissioner Lacey stated she attended the Village meeting and comments were thrown her way. She stated speed bumps in the alley at Hayes, free internet classes for adults, unresponsive police calls for Sawyer Park, and keeping the Community Center open for recreation were addressed. She feels
