Re: COVID-19

The Park District of La Grange places the health and safety of our patrons and staff first and would like to communicate with our patrons on how we are controlling the spread of the coronavirus (COVID-19). We will continue to monitor the daily updates from our Park District Risk Management Agency (PDRMA), the CDC, Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH) and Cook County Department of Health regarding COVID-19 in Illinois. In regards to our facilities, our custodial staff will increase cleaning and sanitation efforts of all touched surfaces of the Recreation Center and satellite buildings, program rooms, indoor playground and program equipment. All program rooms will have additional hand sanitizer, wipes and tissues available for patrons, staff and contractors. We ask that our patrons help in this matter by staying home or keeping your children home if they are showing flu-like symptoms or not feeling well.

For now, the CDC recommends following measures similar to those used to prevent the spread of influenza and other respiratory illnesses.

- Stay home when you are sick.
- Cough or sneeze into your elbow or a tissue.
- Wash your hands regularly with soap and water (for at least 20 seconds).
- Clean surfaces regularly. (It may be possible to contract COVID-19 by touching a surface or object.)
