Fall 2025 Executive Director's Letter

Well, this summer has been a whirlwind! On top of finalizing construction drawings for the Recreation Center expansion, maintenance at the Meadowcrest property (La Grange Park's first new park since 1978), starting the Yena Park renovation, and developing plans for renovations at Robinhood and Stone Monroe Parks – the park district is taking over operations of the fitness center at 1100 E. 31st Street!

We are so very excited to introduce **Community Park Fitness**-A Community Powered fitness and wellness center right here in La Grange Park. The existing facility will be closed from July 18-27. During this time, the park district staff will be deep cleaning, painting, completing immediate repairs, and installing essential IT infrastructure. On July 28, Community Park Fitness will open under park district management and will be overseen by *Fitness Manager*



Spencer Clark.

Spencer has been with the Community Park District since 2019 as our Footlight Players Youth Theater Director. Spencer dedicated tireless nights and weekends over the past 6 years to providing inclusive programming for our young artists. During this time, Spencer was also building significant experience in the fitness industry. Spencer brings private studio management AND nonprofit fitness experience to his new role, and we couldn't be more thrilled that we had the opportunity for him to continue to grow with us.

This summer, the Community Park District also welcomed our *new Superintendent of Recreation, Juan Montes*, to our team. Juan comes to La Grange Park from Addison Park District and his experience in recreation management, athletics, and fitness have already been an incredible asset to our community. This summer, Juan introduced our first adult Pickleball Tournament, developed operational strategies for Community Park Fitness, helped to oversee our first Teen Travel Camp, and helped the park district reach record breaking revenue for summer programs.

If you have ever wondered how the park district is managing to accomplish so much, it truly comes from the response our community has to our programming. As of July 5, our summer program revenue has exceeded \$380,000 - due in large part to the introduction of our summer day camp programs in 2021. This new bank of programs provides has provides essential out-of-school programming and summer experiences for more than 150 local children and their families.



The Community Park District of La Grange Park anticipates generating approximately \$ 5,926,554 in revenue this Fiscal Year – 39% or \$2,323,694 is revenue derived from property taxes. We anticipate seeing \$1,370,800 in recreational program revenue, approximately \$390,000 of which we expect to generate through new fitness center memberships from August 2025-April 2026. We are designing operations to be self-sustaining, meaning that it will not depend on tax dollars for operations.

SCHOOL YEAR SEPTEMBER 9, 2024 - MAY 16, 2025

At Ready Teddy Preschool, we offer a nurturing environment where children ages 1.5-5 years can explore, grow, and build essential skills. Our program is designed to foster development through engaging social play and hands-on learning experiences. With a focus on interactive centers, we lay the foundation for future academic success while encouraging curiosity, creativity and a love for learning.

Registration:

Registration for 2025-2026 School Year requires a nonrefundable registration fee of \$100.00.

Proof of residency is required for La Grange Park residents (Ex: water, gas or electric bill).

All necessary paperwork can be found on our Community Park District website starting in early August.

Enrichment Classes

Our enrichment classes offer engaging opportunities for preschoolers to explore special interests. Look for the Ready Teddy icon to find classes that will enhance your child's day. Additional fees vary by class. Full descriptions and schedules can be found in the fall brochure. Children are supervised to and from all classes.

ABC Before and After School Care

Before and After School Care is an optional program that can be paired with our Ready Teddy Preschool classes. Care is available from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm and is scheduled based on the needs of each student. (Please note: ABC is not offered on party days or school holidays.) Ready Teddy students may register for ABC on their designated class days, with a limit of 4 hours per day. For more information, contact the Park District office at (708) 354-4580.



Friday Learn & Play

Age: 1.5-2 years

This Learn & Play class offers a teacher-led experience with full parent participation, providing a nurturing environment where your child can grow and explore. Activities are designed to encourage early learning through play, socialization, and creative development, while also supporting your child's language, motor, and cognitive skills.

Parents are required to attend with their child, creating a special opportunity for you to engage in your child's learning journey. Through guided activities like music, sensory play, art projects, and interactive games, children will build confidence and begin to develop essential skills. This class is the perfect way to introduce your child to our Ready Teddy community and provide a strong foundation for future preschool experiences. **Tuition is paid per session*








PETS IN THE PARKS POLICY

Animals - No person shall bring any animal in or upon any CPD property without first obtaining a permit from the CPD, unless enrolled in a park district sponsored dog training program. Service animals are excluded from this policy.

1. Dogs are strictly prohibited from all CPD events, except for special events where animals are part of the event with prior CPD approval; from all athletic fields, all tennis courts, all basketball courts; all playgrounds; and parks, except those designated as "Dog Friendly".

2. CPD "Dog Friendly Parks" are defined as:

- A. Memorial Park
- B. Hanesworth Park
- C. Robinhood Park
- D. Stone Monroe Park

3. No person owning or keeping a dog shall allow such dog to run freely in any park, including "Dog Friendly Parks."

4. Dogs must be securely fastened and restrained by a leash not more than six feet in length at all times.5. Dog licenses and proof of vaccinations must be displayed on the dog's collar.

6. No person owning or keeping a dog shall allow such dog to enter upon or remain upon any area of the park utilized as an athletic field, court, children's play area, or posted to prohibit dogs.

7. Owners or keepers of dogs shall carry appropriate equipment to and shall immediately clean the dog's waste and deposit the waste in an appropriate waste receptacle.

8. Aggressive or nuisance animals are prohibited from all parks.

9. Dogs that exhibit aggressive behavior or nuisance barking, must be removed from the park immediately. 10. Any person found in violation of this section shall be fined not less than \$50 or more than \$250
