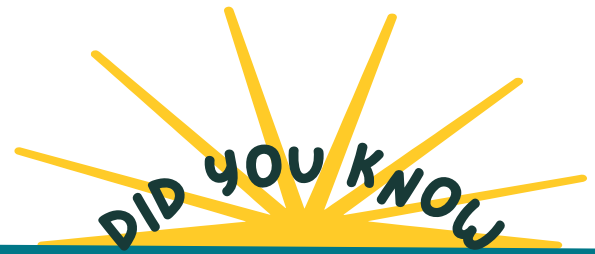

Winter Spring 2026 Executive Director's Letter

It has been quite the year here at the Community Park District! Last spring, we announced the Recreation Center Expansion Project, the acquisition of the new park at Meadowcrest, and the Yena Park overhaul. One thing we did not expect at this time last year, was the possibility of opening and operating a fitness center!

I'm pleased to report that despite the inevitable challenges that come with large projects, in addition to taking on the monumental task of operating a new fitness center here in La Grange Park, we are still on the schedules we anticipated last year!

1 - Community Park Fitness

This was the surprise of 2025! The Community Park District now operates Community Park Fitness, located at 1100 E 31st Street. Thanks to the support of the community and the Greater Metro YMCA, our staff and board were able to renovate and open Community Park Fitness in 10 days! **It is important to note that this facility is self-sustaining and does not rely on tax dollars for its operations.** So, if you are looking for a great place to start, maintain, or elevate your fitness journey, we hope you will give CPF a try! Memberships start at just \$30 per month! All memberships include non-premium group exercise classes and the Family membership includes childcare.

Continued Fitness Center Improvements Every penny that is earned at CPF is reinvested in the facility. The park district board has approved a 10-year lease for the facility, so we are in this with you for the long-haul! As our membership grows and funding becomes available, we will implement critical facility improvements like equipment upgrades, flooring improvements, upgraded member lounge, Community Kids upgrades, and the installation of dry saunas in the locker rooms. We appreciate our members' patience as we continue to make major improvements to this facility. 2 - Recreation Center Expansion

La Grange Park residents will have access to expanded recreational space by the summer of 2027! At the December 8, 2025 meeting, our board will approve a construction contract and we plan to break ground in the early spring. In 12 short months, residents will enjoy access to the only public gymnasium in La Grange Park, an elevated walking track, additional recreational and community gathering space, and Ready Teddy will see significant security improvements.

What does this mean for existing programming?

We are working with our contractor to minimize program interruptions. Ready Teddy and Summer Camp will still be hosted at 1501 Barnsdale Road through 2026 and 2027. We will strategically schedule more intrusive work around holidays and built-in skip days. Please watch www.communityparkdistrict.org for project updates.

3 - La Grange Park is getting a NEW park!

Thanks to a successful Land Water Conservation Fund (LWCF) Grant and the continued success of our recreational programming, the Community Park District successfully acquired 1150 Meadowcrest. The acquisition of the new park resulted in ZERO tax impact to our residents. Our team has completed a portion of the improvements outlined in our grant application with more work scheduled for the spring. The design of the south end of the park was developed with input from our residents during the grant application process. We plan to remove the church building by 2027. We are very grateful to have had the support of the Village Church leadership and congregation to preserve this beautiful open space and the character of the Meadowcrest neighborhood for all future generations of La Grange Park. Per the terms of the LWCF Grant, 1150 Meadowcrest will serve our community as open space in perpetuity.

4 - Yena Park Renovation Near Completion

Despite unanticipated delays this summer, our project manager (JSD) and contractor (Landworks Limited), have worked diligently to keep the Yena Park project on track! This project is funded with \$600,000 in OSLAD Grant funding, \$600,000 in General Obligation Bond proceeds, and approximately \$400,000 in existing capital funding. Thanks to the hard work of our team, we are still on track to open the hard surfaces in the Spring of 2026 and the athletic fields in the fall of 2026 or early spring of 2027.

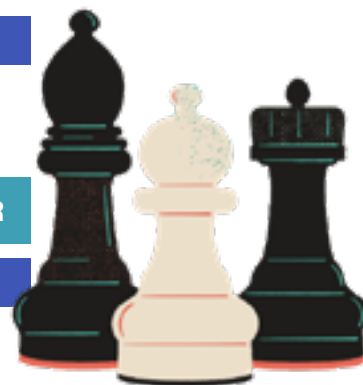

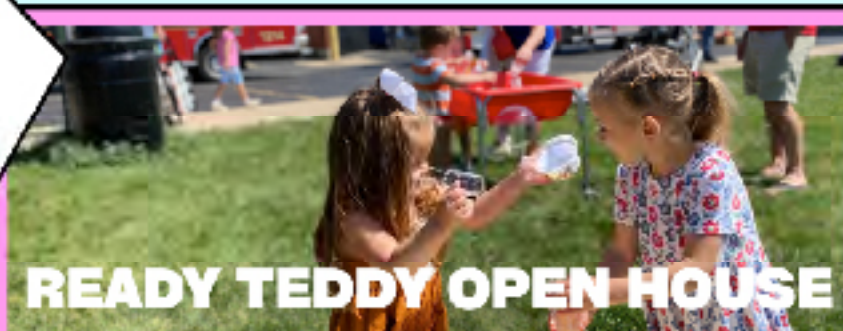

At Ready Teddy Preschool, we offer a nurturing environment where children ages 1.5-5 years can explore, grow, and build essential skills. Registration for 2025-2026 School Year requires a non-refundable registration fee of \$100.00.

Proof of residency is required for La Grange Park residents (Ex: water, gas or electric bill).

All necessary paperwork can be found on our Community Park District website starting in early August.

Enrichment Classes

Our enrichment classes offer engaging opportunities for preschoolers to explore special interests. Look for the Ready Teddy icon to find classes that will enhance your child's day. Additional fees vary by class. Full descriptions and schedules can be found in the fall brochure. Children are supervised to and from all classes.

ABC Before and After School Care

Before and After School Care is an optional program that can be paired with our Ready Teddy Preschool classes. Care is available from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm and is scheduled based on the needs of each student. (Please note: ABC is not offered on party days or school holidays.) Ready Teddy students may register for ABC on their designated class days, with a limit of 4 hours per day. For more information, contact the Park District office at (708) 354-4580.



Friday Learn & Play

Age: 1.5-2 years

This Learn & Play class offers a teacher-led experience with full parent participation, providing a nurturing environment where your child can grow and explore. Activities are designed to encourage early learning through play, socialization, and creative development, while also supporting your child's language, motor, and cognitive skills.

Parents are required to attend with their child, creating a special opportunity for you to engage in your child's learning journey. Through guided activities like music, sensory play, art projects, and interactive games, children will build confidence and begin to develop essential skills. This class is the perfect way to introduce your child to our Ready Teddy community and provide a strong foundation for future preschool experiences.

3-Year-Old Program - Koalas

Our 3-year-old preschool class is designed to foster curiosity, independence, and creativity in a fun and nurturing environment. Through hands-on activities, we introduce children to foundational concepts such as shapes, colors, numbers, and the alphabet. Play-based learning is at the heart of our program with engaging activities like art projects, music, storytelling, and interactive games that promote social skills, emotional growth, and cognitive development.

In this class, children begin to build strong friendships, learn to follow simple routines, and develop their fine and gross motor skills. Our goal is to create a supportive space where children feel confident, loved, and excited about learning as they take their first steps in their educational journey.

3-year-olds have the option to register for MWF and T/Th sessions to create a 5-day experience. Curriculum will be repetitive and Fridays are designed to provide additional social/emotional learning through play opportunities. 1. **Resident Registration:** Online and walk-in resident registration will begin on Thursday, Dec. 5, at 8:30 am. To register online, go to www.communityparkdistrict.org. For walk-in registration, visit the Park District office at 1501 Barnsdale Road, during business hours. Residents may only register their own family members.
2. **Non-resident Registration:** Online and walk-in registration for non-residents begins Thursday, Dec. 12 at 8:30 am. To register online, go to www.communityparkdistrict.org. For walk-in registration, visit the Park District office during normal business hours.
3. **First Come, First Served:** All programs have a minimum and maximum enrollment and will be filled on a first come, first served basis.
4. **Program Waiting Lists:** Maximum enrollments for programs ensure quality and safety for all participants. Waiting lists will be established. Program rosters are monitored for withdrawals and waiting lists are contacted as spots become available. Residents on a waiting list are given priority when an enrollment becomes available.

1. Dogs are strictly prohibited from all CPD events, except for special events where animals are part of the event with prior CPD approval; from all athletic fields, all tennis courts, all basketball courts; all playgrounds; and parks, except those designated as "Dog Friendly".
 2. CPD "Dog Friendly Parks" are defined as:
 - A. Memorial Park
 - B. Hanesworth Park
 - C. Robinhood Park
 - D. Stone Monroe Park
 3. No person owning or keeping a dog shall allow such dog to run freely in any park, including "Dog Friendly Parks."
 4. Dogs must be securely fastened and restrained by a leash not more than six feet in length at all times.
 5. Dog licenses and proof of vaccinations must be displayed on the dog's collar.
 6. No person owning or keeping a dog shall allow such dog to enter upon or remain upon any area of the park utilized as an athletic field, court, children's play area, or posted to prohibit dogs.
 7. Owners or keepers of dogs shall carry appropriate equipment to and shall immediately clean the dog's waste and deposit the waste in an appropriate waste receptacle.
 8. Aggressive or nuisance animals are prohibited from all parks.
 9. Dogs that exhibit aggressive behavior or nuisance barking, must be removed from the park immediately.
 10. Any person found in violation of this section shall be fined not less than \$50 or more than \$250
