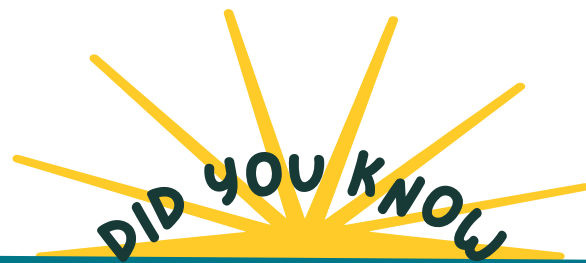

Summer 2026 Executive Director's Letter

Dear Residents and Neighbors,

As you may have noticed, we've been busy this spring. We have several projects underway that will improve some of our most popular outdoor spaces just in time for summer!

- **Robinhood Park Tennis Court Surface** In May, we are scheduled to resurface the tennis courts at Robinhood Park. We will be installing a vibrant, modular athletic surface and replacing the tennis nets and posts. We will also be adding at least one basketball hoop to the fence area.
- **Stone Monroe Tennis Court Surface** As soon as the weather allows, we will begin work at the Stone Monroe Tennis Courts. The surface will be replaced with a similar sand-packed synthetic that is unique to our community.
- **Fitness Court Surface** Between May and June the surface tiles of the fitness courts in Memorial Park will be replaced.
- **Meadowcrest Property** We will be continuing the landscaping improvements at the Meadowcrest (Old Village Church) property into the early months of summer. We will be installing the hardscaping design that was developed with your input during the grant and acquisition process. Meanwhile, we are working on securing details for the future demolition of the church building. Please stay tuned!
- **Work Continues at Yena Park!** Please be patient and kind to the new plantings. As we finish up the work at Yena Park, please know that we will open areas up as we can. It is important to remember that we are installing a wide range of new native plants, turf grass and trees, and these important new plants need to be protected while they acclimate and establish their new home. The natural athletic turf seed will take the longest to establish and the fields are on target to re-open in 2027. The investment you make in native plantings, trees, and natural turf is a significant one. We appreciate your patience as we protect the new plants so they can provide maximum benefits to the community for generations to come.
- **Recreation Center Expansion is Underway!** By the Summer of 2027, our community will enjoy an indoor gymnasium; an elevated walking track; a secure wing for summer camp and preschool programs; new community gathering spaces, expanded recreation space; and so much more!

We have worked diligently through the planning and design process to minimize impact on our existing programs as much as possible. Our goal is to continue to provide a safe and welcoming environment and the highest quality experiences for our participants. 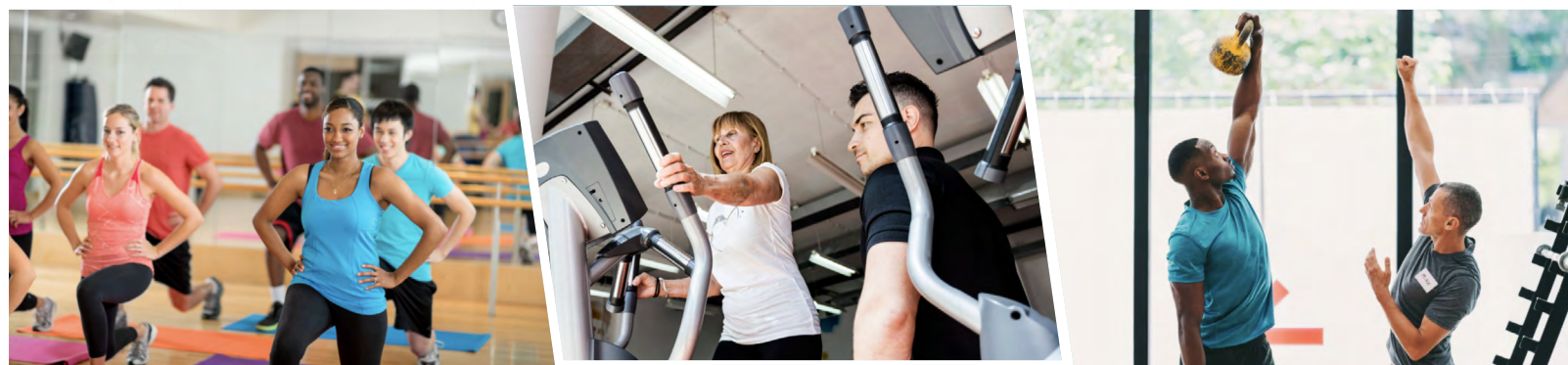

3 Year Old Program - Koalas

REGISTER

Our 3-year-old preschool class is designed to foster curiosity, independence, and creativity in a fun and nurturing environment. Through hands-on activities, we introduce children to foundational concepts such as shapes, colors, numbers, and the alphabet. Play-based learning is at the heart of our program with engaging activities like art projects, music, storytelling, and interactive games that promote social skills, emotional growth, and cognitive development.

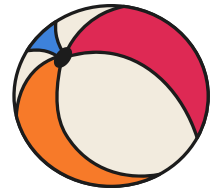

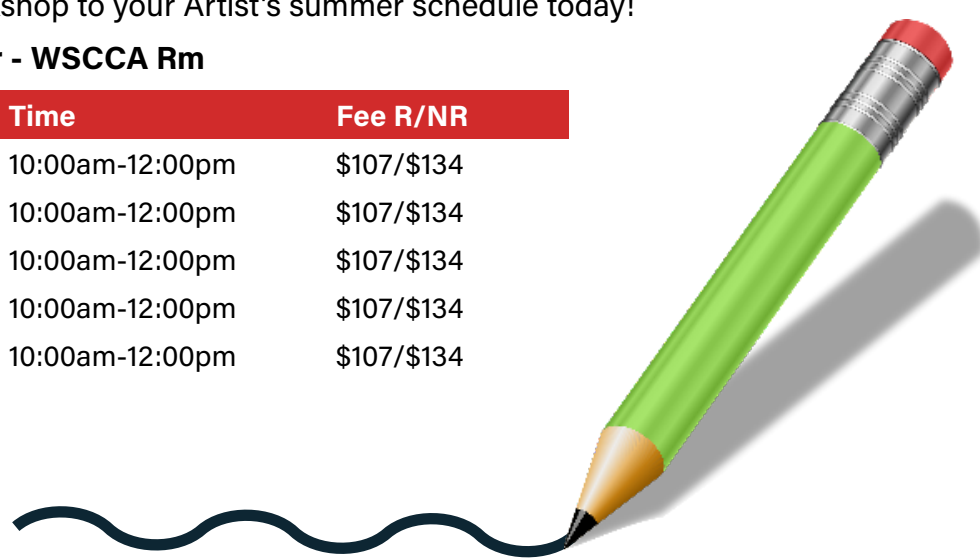

5. **Cancellations:** All classes are subject to cancellation if they do not meet the minimum enrollments a week before the class starts, unless otherwise noted. A full refund will be given.
6. **Refund Policy:** A full refund will be issued if requested within five business days prior to the start of the class. A 20% administrative fee will be applied if request is received within four or fewer business days prior to the start of the class. Prorated refunds MAY be issued, once a class starts, in case of injury or illness. A physician's note may be required. No administrative fee will be applied for a medical release. The following EXCEPTIONS to all above rules apply: Ready Teddy Preschool registration fee and tuition, sports leagues fees, and contractual programs such as tickets to entertainment and special events and trips.
7. **NSF:** A non-sufficient fund fee will apply, in the event that a program is paid for by a check and that check is returned to the District stamped NSF or Closed Account. A full payment will be required in cash or cashier's check before attendance in a class can continue. A fee will be added, up to \$25.00 for all checks returned.
8. **Proof of Residency:** Proof of residency may be required to qualify for resident rates for program registration. A state ID or current utility bill is acceptable.
9.  **Co-Op Programming:** If the graphic symbol appears next to a program title, it is a cooperative program and resident rates will apply to all agencies included.
10. **Proof of Age:** The Community Park District reserves the right to require proof of age for participants when age is a factor.
11. **Payment Methods:** We accept VISA, MasterCard, Discover, American Express, cash and checks. Proper ID might be required.
12. **Absolutely NO money or registration will be accepted at any class site. All registrations must** be processed and completed either online or at the Park District office during normal business hours.

PETS IN THE PARKS POLICY

1. Dogs are strictly prohibited from all CPD events, except for special events where animals are part of the event with prior CPD approval; from all athletic fields, all tennis courts, all basketball courts; all playgrounds; and parks, except those designated as "Dog Friendly".
 2. CPD "Dog Friendly Parks" are defined as:
 - A. Memorial Park
 - B. Hanesworth Park
 - C. Robinhood Park
 - D. Stone Monroe Park
 3. No person owning or keeping a dog shall allow such dog to run freely in any park, including "Dog Friendly Parks."
 4. Dogs must be securely fastened and restrained by a leash not more than six feet in length at all times.
 5. Dog licenses and proof of vaccinations must be displayed on the dog's collar.
 6. No person owning or keeping a dog shall allow such dog to enter upon or remain upon any area of the park utilized as an athletic field, court, children's play area, or posted to prohibit dogs.
 7. Owners or keepers of dogs shall carry appropriate equipment to and shall immediately clean the dog's waste and deposit the waste in an appropriate waste receptacle.
 8. Aggressive or nuisance animals are prohibited from all parks.
 9. Dogs that exhibit aggressive behavior or nuisance barking, must be removed from the park immediately.
 10. Any person found in violation of this section shall be fined not less than \$50 or more than \$250
