BIPOLAR DISORDER CENTER IN THE MULVA CLINIC FOR THE NEUROSCIENCES

The Bipolar Disorder Center team's goal is to reduce the burden in people's lives of both the illness and its treatments side effects. The care team provides counseling, psychiatric consultation and prevention services that facilitate patients' life goals and enhance their personal growth and well-being. The center operates on a referral basis only and treats patients from 16-35 years old diagnosed with bipolar disorder. Patients undergo a six-week program focused on treating depressive and manic symptoms with the aim of enhancing function. COGNITIVE DISORDERS CENTER IN THE MULVA CLINIC FOR NEUROSCIENCES

The Cognitive Disorders Center care team provides evaluation and treatment to patients and families who are living with conditions that impact memory, behavior and other cognitive functions. They provide diagnostic evaluation and evidence-based treatments for individuals with memory concerns, mild cognitive impairment, Alzheimer's disease, vascular dementia, frontal temporal dementia, primary progressive aphasia, semantic dementia, corticobasal syndrome, rapidly progressive dementia and dementia with lewy bodies. The goal is to help determine what is causing the changes a patient is experiencing and support the patient throughout the process.
