


Quick Reference Guide for Reveal Driver Users

Sign In and Find a Stop

- 1. Sign in to Reveal Driver.
- 2. Tap a region (North America, Asia-Pacific, or Europe).
- 3. Select a vehicle, and then tap **Continue**.
- On the Today screen, tap Stops to open the Current tab on the Stops screen.

The numbered markers on the map show the location of each stop. The stops are listed in the lower part of the screen.

- Outstanding Complete these first. These are stops that should have been completed, but haven't yet.
- Today Stops that should be completed today.



5. Tap a stop to open the **Stop Details** screen and view more details about the stop.

Navigate to a Stop

- On the Stop Details screen, tap
 Directions
- From the list of options, tap
 "Navigation", and then tap **OK**.
 The Navigation app opens and calculates the route from your current location to the stop address.
- On the Route Overview screen, review the route.
 You might want do one of the following:
 - Tap the **Hazmat** icon to review or edit the hazardous material settings, if they are defined for your vehicle:




Tap to review or edit other settings.

Note: To return to Reveal Driver, tap •.

- 4. Tap to start navigating to the stop. Turn-by-turn directions are displayed on the **Guidance** screen.
- 5. Follow the directions to the stop.
- When you have arrived at the stop and want to return to Reveal Driver, tap
 Menu = , and then tap "Reveal Driver".

Change the Status of a Stop

 On the Reveal Driver **Stops** screen, locate the stop and then swipe left to view the following options:



- 2. Tap an option to change the status of the stop.
 - Complete tap this when a stop has been completed. Completed stops listed on the History screen.

- Refuse tap this to refuse a stop.
 Refused stops are listed on the
 History screen.
- In Progress tap this to give the stop the "In Progress" status.
- 3. Tap the white area to hide the options.

Edit Vehicle Settings In

Navigation

- 1. In Navigation, tap **Menu** =
- 2. Tap "Settings" > "Vehicle".
- 3. On the **Vehicle** screen, edit the vehicle settings.
