Ibis Networks respects your privacy and is committed to protecting it through our compliance with this policy.

This policy describes the types of information we may collect from you or that you may provide when you visit the web site and our practices for collecting, using, maintaining, protecting, and disclosing that information.

Please read this policy carefully to understand our policies and practices regarding your information and how we will treat it. If you do not agree with our policies and practices, your choice is not to use our web site. By accessing or using our web site, you agree to this privacy policy. This policy may change from time to time (see [Changes to Our Privacy Policy](#)). Your continued use of this web site after we make changes is deemed to be acceptance of those changes, so please check the policy periodically for updates.

What information do we collect?

We collect your contact information, including name, email, address, and phone number, when you register on ibis.io.

When the Ibis System is installed, we collect device type and location information for each device plugged into an IntelliSocket, and network configuration information for each IntelliGateway. Once the Ibis System is installed, we collect energy usage information for each of these devices.

When you access the site, we automatically collect connection information such as your IP address and browser type, and we log page views and data requests.

What do we use your information for?

Any of the information we collect from you may be used in the following ways:

- To personalize your experience with the web site
- To control access to collected energy data
- To provide summary and analytic analysis of your energy use
- To build anonymized, aggregate summary data

Ibis may draw on data from multiple customers to build summary statistics for device brands, geographic locations, or other common attributes. All identifying information is removed in the process of building these summaries.

- To send alert messages

You may request to be alerted of significant or out-of-bound events identified in the energy data, and you may cancel the alert notifications at any time.

- To send system notifications

Ibis may send notifications to warn of scheduled down time or system upgrades.

How do we protect your information?

We implement a variety of industry-standard security measures to maintain the safety and integrity of your personal data.

We have implemented measures designed to secure your personal information from accidental loss and from unauthorized access, use, alteration, and disclosure. All information you provide to us is stored on our secure servers behind firewalls.

The safety and security of your information also depends on you. Where we have given you (or where you have chosen) a password for access to certain parts of our web site, you are responsible for keeping this password confidential. We ask you not to share your password with anyone.

Unfortunately, the transmission of information via the Internet is not completely secure. Although we do our best to protect your personal information, we cannot guarantee the security of your personal information transmitted to our web site. Any transmission of personal information is at your own risk. We are not responsible for circumvention of any privacy settings or security measures contained on the web site.

Do we use cookies?

Yes. As is common practice with almost all professional websites this site uses cookies, which are tiny files that are downloaded to your computer.

The Cookies We Set

We use cookies when you are logged in so that we can remember this fact. This prevents you from having to log in every single time you visit a new page. These cookies are typically removed or cleared when you log out to ensure that you can only access restricted features and areas when logged in. We do not use cookies that cross domains, and thus do not participate in uses of cookies that would identify your account on ibis.io with third party accounts on any other service provider or media outlet.

Do we disclose any information to outside parties?

We do not sell, trade, or otherwise transfer to outside parties your personally identifiable information. We do not share any collected energy information with outside parties unless you have agreed to let us do so. We may release your information to law enforcement when we believe release is appropriate to comply

with the law, enforce our site policies, or protect our or other's rights, property, or safety.
