


Zadar to Dubrovnik Cruise with Lori Wolf Clark

Day by Day Program



Day 1, June 04, 2020: depart home cities for Zagreb
(Kollander travel can assist with flight arrangements.)

Day 2, June 05, 2020: arrive Zagreb, Friday

You will be met at the airport and transferred to your hotel (one group transfer). Proceed with a comprehensive sightseeing through the historic Upper Town. See St. Mark's Church, St. Catherine's Church, the **Cathedral**, Parliament, and the Government Palace. Dinner and overnight. (D)

Day 3, June 06, 2020: Zagreb – Plitvice Lakes – Zadar, Saturday

Head south for a visit to magnificent **Plitvice Lakes National Park**, a UNESCO World Heritage site. Enjoy the breathtaking scenery of this natural wonder with its 16 terraced lakes surrounded by forested mountains and lush vegetation. A walking tour takes you around several of the lower lakes. On to Zadar and the port to embark on our boat. Later, gather with your fellow "sailors" for a Welcome Reception on board followed by dinner. (B, D)

Day 4, June 07, 2020: Zadar – Sali, Sunday

Zadar historical center is a pedestrian zone, perfect to explore on foot. Set out on a walking tour and admire the 16th-century walls built in by Venetians as a defense from The Turks. On to see the 16th century Port Gate where the Venetian lion still stands guard over the entrance, the Square of the Five Wells, **Church of St. Donat**, the Roman Forum (1st century BC) and the largest cathedral in Dalmatia, **St. Anastasia**. Returning to the boat, enjoy lunch as you sail to Sali. Explore the town tonight, and have dinner on your own in one of the restaurants. (B, L)

Day 5, June 08, 2020: Sali – Sibenik, Monday

Take in the scenic natural beauty of two National Parks today. Start in **Kornati**, home to more than 140 islands with numerous coves and crystal clear waters. Stop for a swim during your lunchtime cruise. Next is **Krka**, with its breathtaking waterfalls. After your visit here, coach to Sibenik where your ship is anchored. Your evening is at leisure in town. (B, L)

Day 6, June 09, 2020: Sibenik – Trogir – Split, Tuesday

Take a break for a swim during your morning cruise. Sail through lunch, arriving in the UNESCO-listed city of Trogir this afternoon. There's time on your own before heading to Split. Here, a walking tour of the historic inner city shows off the Roman Emperor **Diocletian's Palace**, a UNESCO World Cultural Heritage site. See the remnants of Split's Roman heritage, its Renaissance and Gothic structures, Jupiter's Temple, the Peristyle, and the Cathedral. (B, L)



Day by Day Program



Day 7, June 10, 2020: Split – Bol – Hvar, Wednesday

Stop in Bol, home to one of the best beaches in Croatia, the Golden Horn. This long, golden pebble beach is unique in that it changes shape and position depending on the winds. Go for a swim in the clear blue waters before sailing to Hvar. Here, a sightseeing tour includes views of the first public theatre in Europe (older than Shakespeare's theatre in the UK), the Franciscan Monastery, and many more historic sights. The evening is free to explore Hvar and to dine on your own at one of the excellent restaurants. **(B, L)**

Note: Due to the limited capacity of the Hvar harbor (during peak season in July and August) port of call can be substituted for Stari Grad/Jelsa. In that case transfer by bus will be organized to and from Hvar.

Day 8, June 11, 2020: Hvar – Korcula – Mljet, Thursday

After breakfast set sail for Korcula, with an early afternoon arrival. Korcula town is thought to be the birthplace of the famous explorer Marco Polo. Take a walking tour through its narrow, cobbled streets and visit the majestic Gothic-Baroque **Cathedral of St. Mark**. Continue sailing to the island of Mljet, where you will enjoy the afternoon tour of **Mljet National Park**, as you walk around the Great and Small Lakes. This lovely island was supposedly a favorite holiday spot for the Greek hero Ulysses! Tonight, enjoy **captain's dinner** with live entertainment on board your ship. **(B, L, D)**

Day 9, June 12, 2020: Mljet – Dubrovnik, Friday

In the morning sail to Dubrovnik, so called "Pearl of Adriatic," a UNESCO World Heritage site. While in

Dubrovnik, take a walking tour of the old town and visit the **Rector's Palace** and Franciscan Monastery with its **Pharmacy**. Remainder of the day is free; perhaps discover this lovely city on own or enjoy last minute souvenir shopping. **(B, L)**

Day 10, June 13, 2020: depart Dubrovnik, Saturday

Disembark after breakfast. You will be transferred to Dubrovnik airport for your flight home. **(B)**

Abbreviations: B-Breakfast, L-Lunch, D-Dinner.

Note: Day tours involve walking at times on uneven surfaces.

1. Final Payment Due: **February 1, 2020**.
2. Kollander World Travel will quote airfare from your home city. Call for a quote.
3. Baggage Allowance: Baggage fees may apply. Check with your carrier for fees and size/weight of bags allowed. However the tour operator has requested that there be a limit of 1 large suitcase at 50 lbs. per person due to space restrictions aboard the motor coach. **NO RESPONSIBILITY IS INCURRED FOR LOSS OF OR DAMAGE TO BAGGAGE OR ANY OF THE PASSENGER'S PERSONAL BELONGINGS. TRAVEL BAGGAGE INSURANCE IS RECOMMENDED AND AVAILABLE THROUGH KOLLANDER WORLD TRAVEL.**
4. Passport Requirements: A valid passport is required of all tour participants. A U.S. passport is valid for 10 years. Your passport must be valid for at least 6 months following your return to the United States. To apply for passports you can contact your local passport office. Kollander World Travel will be happy to help you obtain the necessary forms.
5. Tour Price Excludes: Airport departure taxes, customs user fees, passports, all visa fees, optional tours, telephone, telex, fax and telegram charges, excess baggage charges, sundry tips, laundry, beverages and food not on the regular table d'hôtel menu (these items will be billed to you before leaving the hotel, or restaurant), portage at U.S./Canada airports and all other items of a personal nature. Service charges at hotels and restaurants are prepaid. Travel insurance is not included.
6. Refund and Unused or Amended Tour Arrangements: Unused hotel accommodations, tour features, or services are non-refundable, not exchangeable for other accommodations, any additional expenses will be charged to the tour members. If a change becomes necessary for any reason, hotel substituted will be the equivalent of those shown. Single room available at a supplemental charge.
7. Cancellation Penalties: If you cancel your reservations, your right to receive a refund is limited as set forth in the following schedule. All requests for refunds must be sent to us in writing. Charges for cancellations of the tour will be assessed by the participating airlines, tour operators, and hotels as follows:
 - After deposit _____ U.S. \$350.00 per person (non-refundable),
 - 60-30 days prior to departure _____ U.S. 75% per person,
 - 29 days or less prior to departure _____ 100% Penalty and No Refund.Once airfare is purchased, airfare is non-refundable. Cancellation charges also apply to additional accommodations reserved prior to and after the tour.

8. Insurance. While every effort is made to ensure that baggage is properly handled and that the cancellation charges to you are kept to a minimum, Kollander World Travel cannot be held responsible for damages, loss or theft of luggage or personal belongings. If the Company cancels a tour, it shall have no responsibility beyond the refund of all monies paid to the Company by the tour participant.
