The Educational Justice Center, along with focus on equal access, redistribution, participation and compensation in various areas of research, also includes analyses about gender inequality and the climate crisis, which are considered as fundamental issues to explain the current crises. CJE is convinced that only when the concept of justice is not oriented to a crisis, it can lead to a normalizing project, which will reproduce what is exactly trying to be resolved.

Through interdisciplinary and multi-methodological research, the CJE aims at identifying and understanding the way that Educational Justice can take shape in educational space, so as to offer appropriate public policies and pedagogical practices to the current demands in various contexts, educational levels, and social groups. In particular, the CJE proposes:

- Develop interdisciplinary research in education at the frontiers of knowledge.
- Form advanced human capital for education and educational research.
- Generate scientific knowledge and innovation in education.
- Support the development of public policies and the dissemination of knowledge to promote justice, inclusion and quality of education.

Research Lines:

- Is the pedagogical participation of diverse students in the classroom fair?
- Are the paths of inclusion fair for students with special educational needs?
- Are the methodologies that we use to investigate educational justice fair?
- Are the social experiences of migrant and indigenous children and adolescents fair?
- Are early childhood care pathways fair?
- Are the new educational regulations under privatization fair?



>> MAIN ACHIEVEMENTS:

- Advice on the creation of "Initial Plan", an initiative that proposed reforms in early education to the Ministry of Education.
- Contributions in the parliamentary debate of the "Fair Admission Bill" during 2019.
- Outstanding participation in the "Final Report on Covid-19 in Education", requested by the President's National Advisory Council on COVID-19 (2020).
- Participation of researchers in 20 advisory councils, committees and other instances to support those leaders on public policies.
- Organization of the 25th Congress "Aesthetic and Pedagogic Entanglements" of the International Research Society for Children's Literature (IRSCL) (2021).
- Significant accumulation of evidence during the first stage of the Center, expressed in 157 academic publications and 215 presentations at national and international conferences.
