The MIGRA Millennium Nucleus: Perceptions and Consequences of Immigration (MIGRA) focus on understanding the consequences, the triggers for public perceptions, and the possible mismatches between reality and perceptions about immigration in Chile.

The migrant population quadrupled during the last decade, generating unprecedented sociodemographic changes in the recent history of Chile. This rapid increase has occurred at a delicate institutional moment. In 2022 the 1975 Immigration Law was reformed. The new law instructs the president to formulate a comprehensive immigration policy soon to be implemented. MIGRA seeks to contribute to understanding the consequences of the recent migratory wave in Chile in objective and subjective dimensions of well-being and the impact of institutional responses on the national and migrant populations.

The objective of the Nucleus is to examine the impact of immigration in specific areas of social integration, such as work, education, health, security, and law, with a particular focus on understanding the triggers of public perceptions and how better address possible mismatches between reality and perceptions towards immigration.

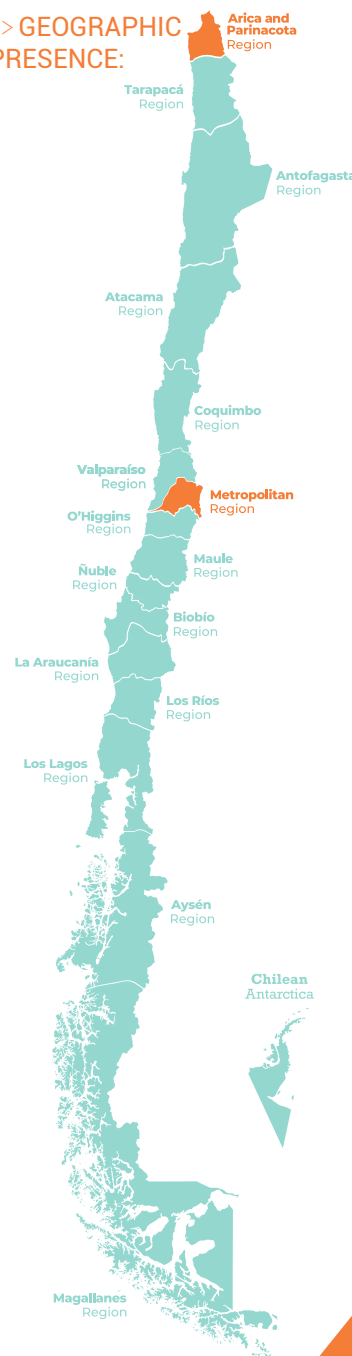
