- 4) Is the location of the hearing ADA accessible?
- 5) Where/how is the hearing being advertised?
- 6) Will you be handing out any public documents, e.g., comment cards, maps, or vital information related to the project, during or before the hearing? If so, what are they?
- 7) Do you anticipate any non-English speakers to be in attendance at the hearing?
- 8) Will this project impact minority, low-income, or limited English proficient persons or groups in the community, either positively or negatively? If so, how?
