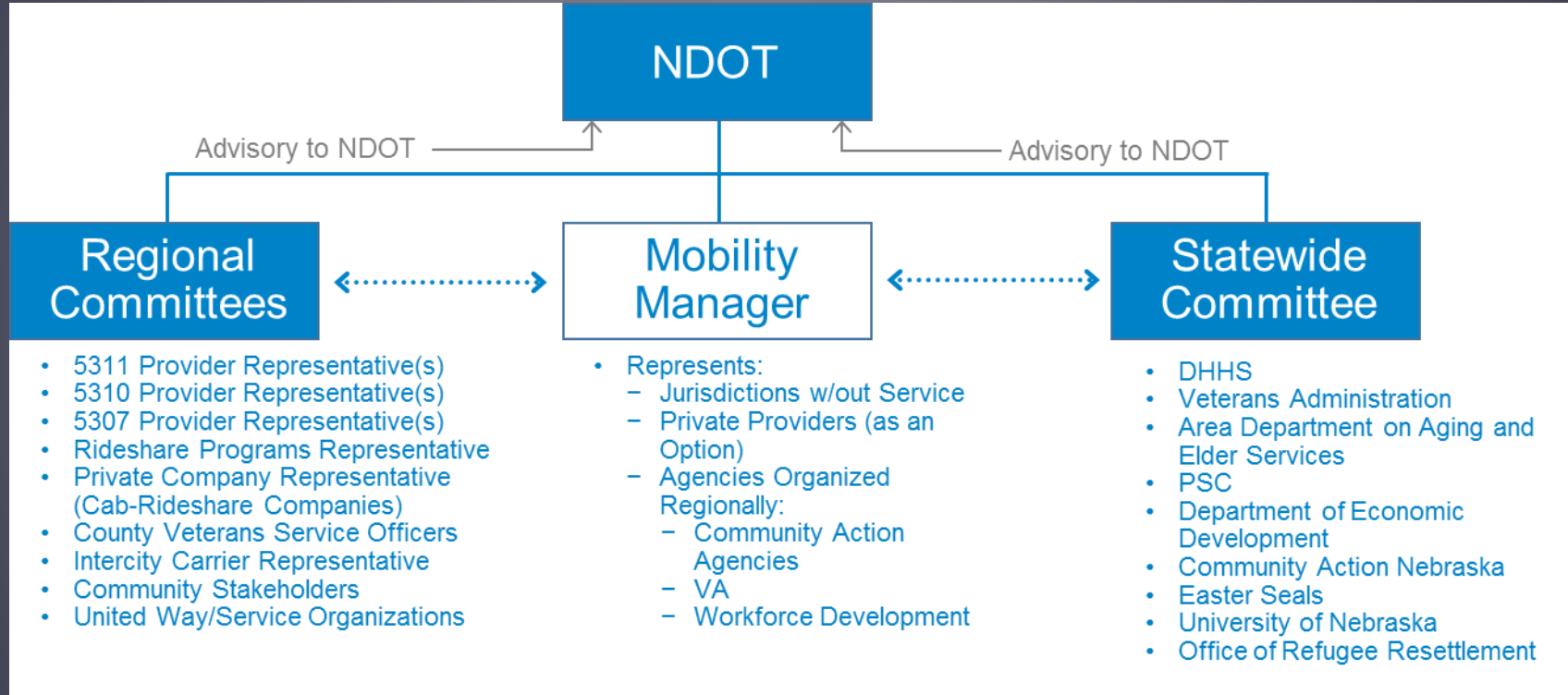

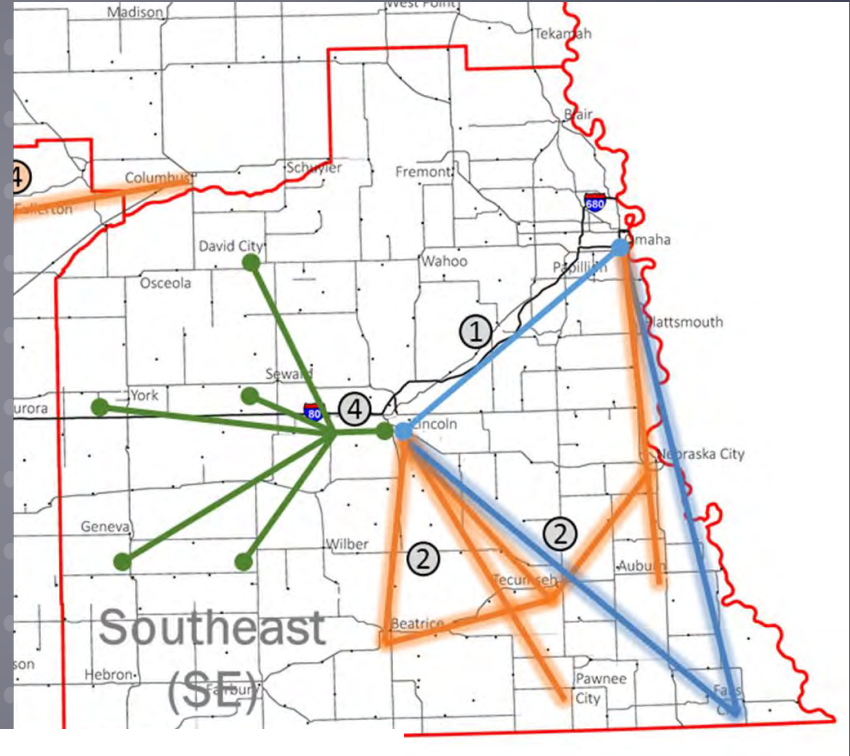

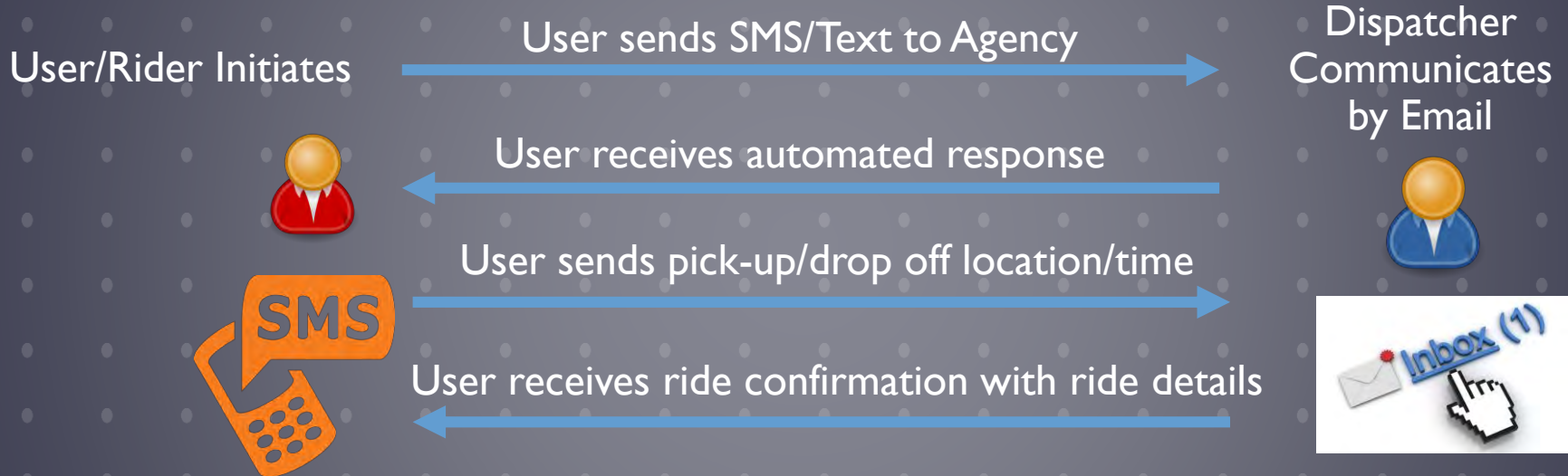

RESERVATIONS APPLICATION

- ▶ Rural Providers – Regional Trips to Start
- ▶ Provides Another Option for Communication:
 - ▶ After Hours
 - ▶ While Occupied with Other Activity
- ▶ Reservations Only

The application consists of four sequential screens:

- Create your username and enter information:** Fields for Name, Email Address, Phone Number, Username, and Password. A "Create Profile" button is at the bottom.
- When do you need a ride?:** A calendar interface to select a date and time. Below are fields for "Street Address 1", "Street Address 2", and "City/Town". A "Next" button is at the bottom right.

 - ▶ Extension of service hours might be needed



Johnson County (Tecumseh) transit provides service from Tecumseh to Lincoln every 3rd Monday of the Month. Stops are being offered in Cook, Syracuse, Unadilla, Palmyra, Saint Mary, Sterling, Adams, Panama and Bennet to pick-up and drop-off residents wanting to travel to Lincoln.




Schedule for Trips
Our buses run curb-to-curb. We'll pick you up, take you to your destination, and drop you off back at home. No rushing to the bus stop, no waiting in inclement weather, no wondering if you missed the bus.

Please call at least two business day before the scheduled trip day with the appointment time, location, contact phone number and preferred stops in Lincoln. This helps us provide everyone the best possible service. (The selection of bus path (route A or B) will depend on the reservations on a first come first serve basis.)
