Homerun Derby

Rules

- Players will need to use a legal AHSAA bat.
- Players must provide their own pitcher. One pitcher can pitch to multiple girls.
 - Once a player begins her round with her pitcher, the participant will not be allowed to change pitchers unless an injury occurs.
- Batters will have to stay in the batter's box and will not be allowed to move up.
- A missed swing, foul ball, and anything not hit over the fence in fair will count as an out.
- Batters DO NOT have to swing at every pitch.
- The top 50% of players will advance to the next rounds.
 - Players scores will build through qualifying rounds.
 - In the event of a tie during the qualifying rounds, each player will be given 5 swings. The most home runs will move on. This number will NOT roll over to their score.
 - The championship round will start with each player on a blank slate—0 home runs.
- Balls will be provided.
- The winner will receive a new Demarini CF Zen 34/24. If the bat size is different than what the winner uses, the winner's bat size will be ordered and delivered.
- If there are < 16 participants
 - Each qualifying round will consist of 10 outs. There will be a maximum of 13 home runs each qualifying round.
 - The Championship round will consist of 10 outs.
- If there are between 16-24 participants
 - Each qualifying round will consist of 7 outs with a maximum of 13 home runs each round.
 - The championship round will consist of 10 outs.
- If there are > 25 participants
 - Each qualifying round will consist of 7 outs with a maximum of 20 pitches.
 - The championship round will consist of 7 outs.
