The table below provides you with topics/stories and verses that can guide you as you read through the Bible this January and explore God's Truth. The passages do not need to be studied in any particular order, so feel free to select the studies that would work best for you and your group over this next month.

PURSUE: READ THE TRUTH

To have a better understanding of what God's Word is, we need to be reading His Word daily. As you work through these Discovery Bible Studies, you will begin to discover why it is important to "Read the Truth." You will learn that God's Word will help you face battles, gain direction, resist temptation and much more. Reading the Truth is a critical step as we continue to pursue the things that God has for us.

DISCOVERY BIBLE STUDY TRAINING

Use the model and information below to guide and lead your FCA Huddle.

WARM UP

Welcome and Quick Conversation Starters:

- What are you thankful for?
- What are you struggling with?

WORKOUT

Accountability from previous week (note, skip this if it is your first meeting):

- How did you obey last week? ("I will..." statement)
- Who did you share with?

Bible reading (choose a passage from the suggested story sets):

- Read the passage aloud, everyone follows along with their eyes.
- Read the passage a second time, but this time close your eyes and listen.
- Together, retell the story in as much detail as you can without looking at the Bible.

Bible study (reopen your Bibles and answer these questions verse by verse):

- What does this say about God?
- What does this say about people?

WRAP UP

Take Action:

- Consider the truths about God and people that you wrote down.
- Answer the following questions:
 - By God's grace, how will you obey God's Word this week?
 - Pray and ask God what truth He wants you to focus on this week.
 - Write a one-sentence, "I will..." statement capturing this conviction.
 - Who will you share this Scripture passage with this week?
 - Pray and ask God who needs to hear this.
 - Write down one name and be intentional about sharing with them.
