CIVIL OR HUMANIST CEREMONY

The dramatic Boconnoc House, beautiful 18th Century Stable Yard, Bath House or Dorothy
Garden can be used for your civil ceremony for up to 200 guests. A humanist ceremony
can be held on the lawns in front of the house, down by the lake or by the Celtic cross; the
possibilities are endless. We also include use of our beautiful rustic cross back chairs and a
table for your registrar or celebrant to use.











CHURCH WEDDING

The historic church seats 240 people but is equally cosy for a smaller wedding.

Keep an eye out for some of the unique aspects of the church, including the minute detail on the stained glass window, said to be Pre-Raphaelite.







DRINKS RECEPTION

In the sunshine the lawn is perfect for drinks. Get the champagne on ice and let your guests absorb the spectacular views whilst nibbling on delicious canapes in the warm sun.

Alternatively, the elegant and spacious Drawing Room with its ornate plasterwork and modern art provides the perfectly sophisticated space to clink glasses.

WEDDING BREAKFAST

With windows on three sides, light pours into the Garden Room which seats 100 guests. This space opens on to a wisteria filled terrace which can be covered with a marquee if you require up to 240 guests.










THE PARTY

BOCONNOC HOUSE

The main house can sleep 18 guests. Each twin or double room has its own bathroom and we recommend you choose the King's Bedroom for your wedding night which has dramatic palladian windows looking out across the park.





COTTAGES

There are three beautiful cottages next to the house in the Stable Yard, each with their own charming character and contemporary interiors. The ample accommodation means that most of your wedding party can stay onsite, which is perfect for those travelling down for the weekend.

GLAMPING

For further accommodation why not consider setting up a tented village in our Dorothy Garden.

Some facilities are available in the Stable Yard and depending on numbers we may recommend hiring in additional loos and showers.

Watergate Bay and Polzeath on the north coast are both popular surfing hot spots.


Canoeing & Kayaking
