

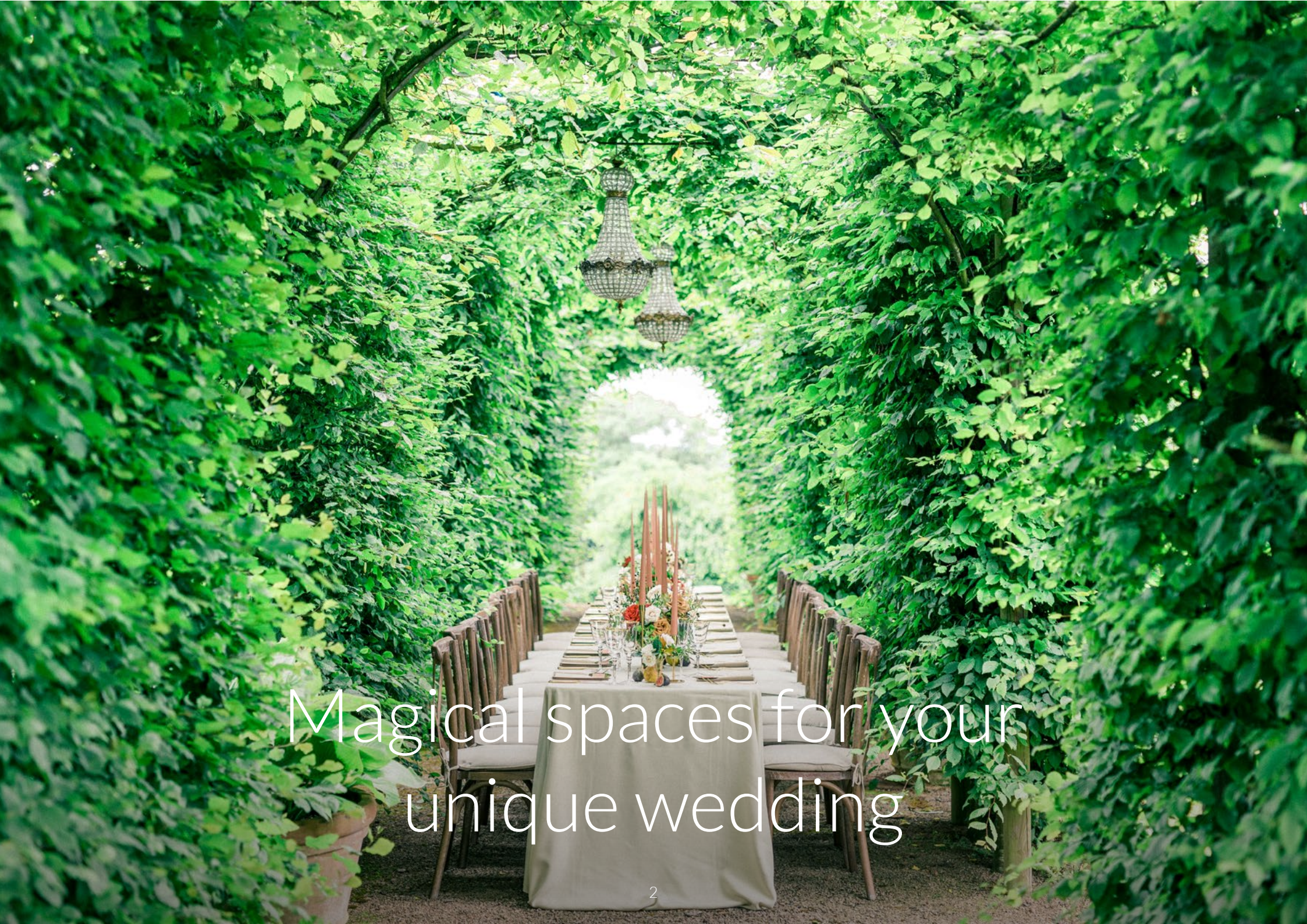

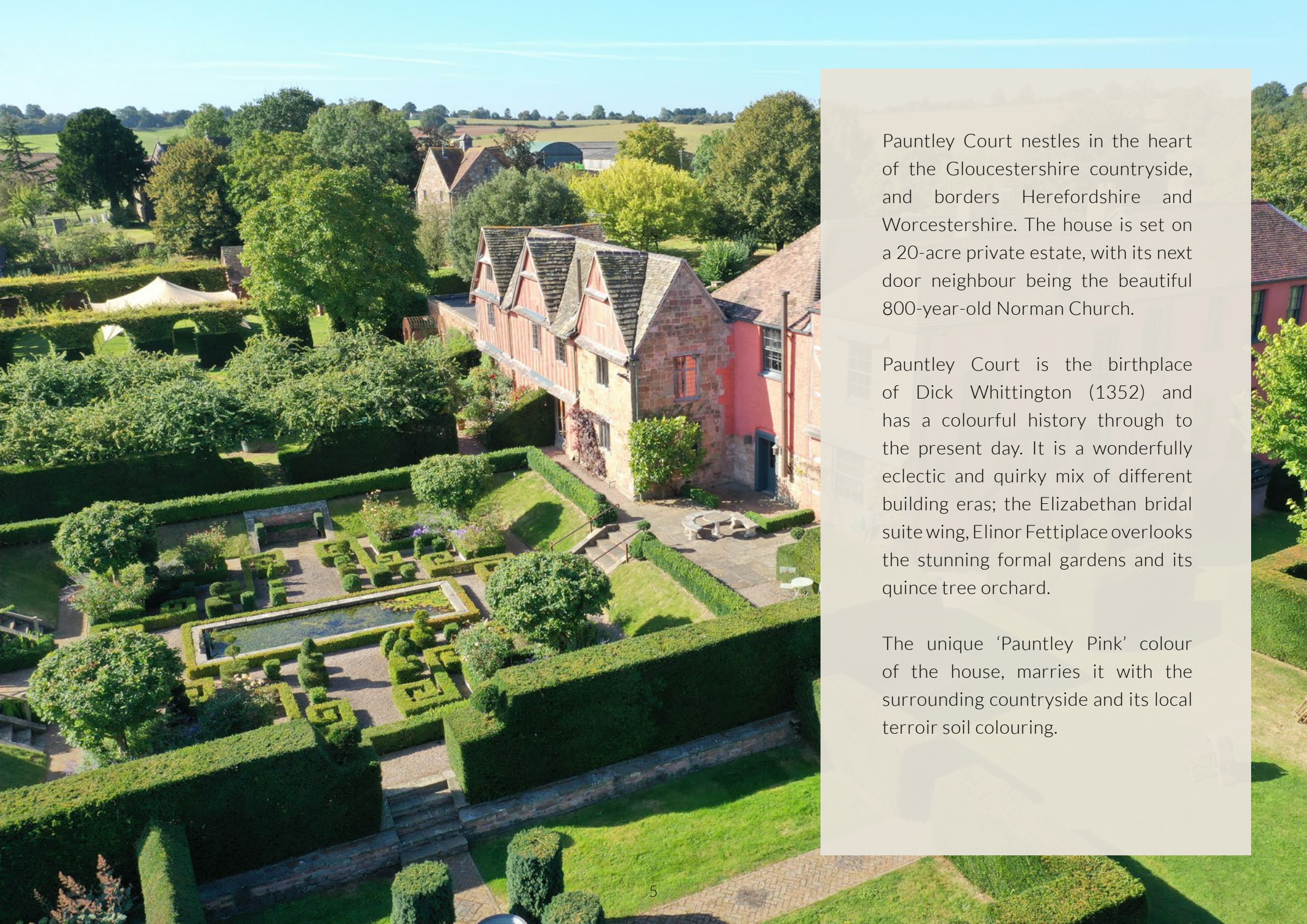

Pauntley Court nestles in the heart of the Gloucestershire countryside, and borders Herefordshire and Worcestershire. The house is set on a 20-acre private estate, with its next door neighbour being the beautiful 800-year-old Norman Church.

Pauntley Court is the birthplace of Dick Whittington (1352) and has a colourful history through to the present day. It is a wonderfully eclectic and quirky mix of different building eras; the Elizabethan bridal suite wing, Elinor Fettiplace overlooks the stunning formal gardens and its quince tree orchard.

The unique 'Pauntley Pink' colour of the house, marries it with the surrounding countryside and its local terroir soil colouring.



Church ceremonies

Pauntley Court is next door to an exquisite 800 year old Norman Church, which can seat up to 100 guests. Just a stone's throw from the Main House, this beautiful church is a romantic stroll through a private gate in the gardens.



Civil and humanist ceremonies

The Ballroom has space for up to 40 guests for a civil or humanist ceremony while the stunning formal gardens, magical woodland and gorgeous lake offer wildly romantic settings for an outdoor ceremony option.

Micro Wedding

Up to 16 guests from £7,750

Enjoy the exclusive use of the Pauntley Court Estate with your family and close friends for 3 days and 2 nights. Get married in the beautiful Norman church just next door or choose an intimate civil ceremony in the elegant Ballroom followed by drinks and canapes in the Panelled Room or under the stretch tent. A special wedding breakfast for 16 can be in the Ballroom or outside under the stretch tent or perhaps beneath the magical hornbeam arches.

Why not hire some games such as giant Jenga or chess for your guests or perhaps just enjoy the time to chat and laugh and celebrate before your guests retire to their luxurious bedrooms. The large Main House kitchen is the perfect space for breakfast the next day with your family and friends.





Petite Wedding

Up to 24 guests from £9,075

You will have exclusive hire of the Pauntley Court Estate, including the main house, the bridal suite and the 16th century Dovecote. With stunning gardens and 20 acres to walk in, stay with your close family and friends for 3 days and 2 nights in the beautiful accommodation and make Pauntley Court your home for the weekend.

Enjoy a relaxed pre-wedding day supper in the Flower Room or on the new terrace in the walled garden. Perhaps have grazing boards delivered or homemade pizzas from Dom the Pizza Man and his converted horsebox.

Choose to get married in the 800-year-old Norman church next door or a civil ceremony in the wonderful 'Ballroom', before moving through to drinks and canapes on the spectacular formal gardens and flat lawns. Have a fabulous wedding breakfast under the stretch tent or beneath the quince trees.

Up to 100 guests from £10,995

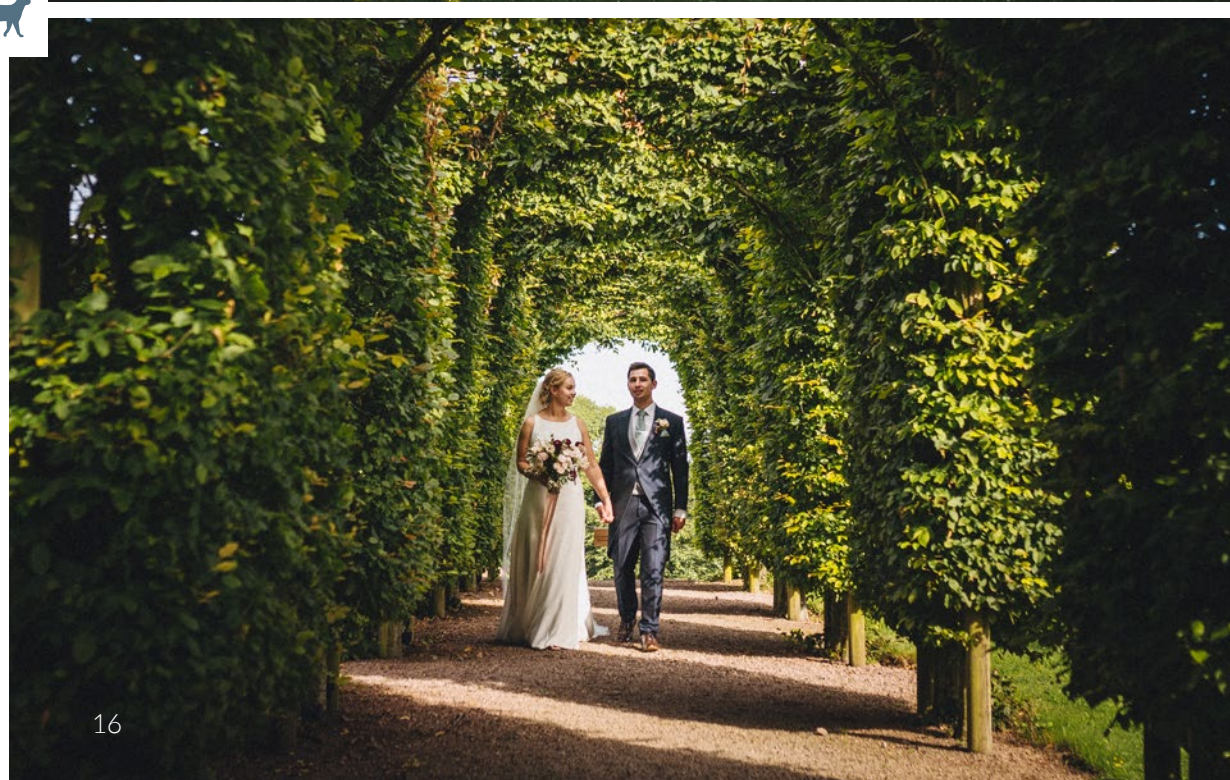

Elinor Fettiplace

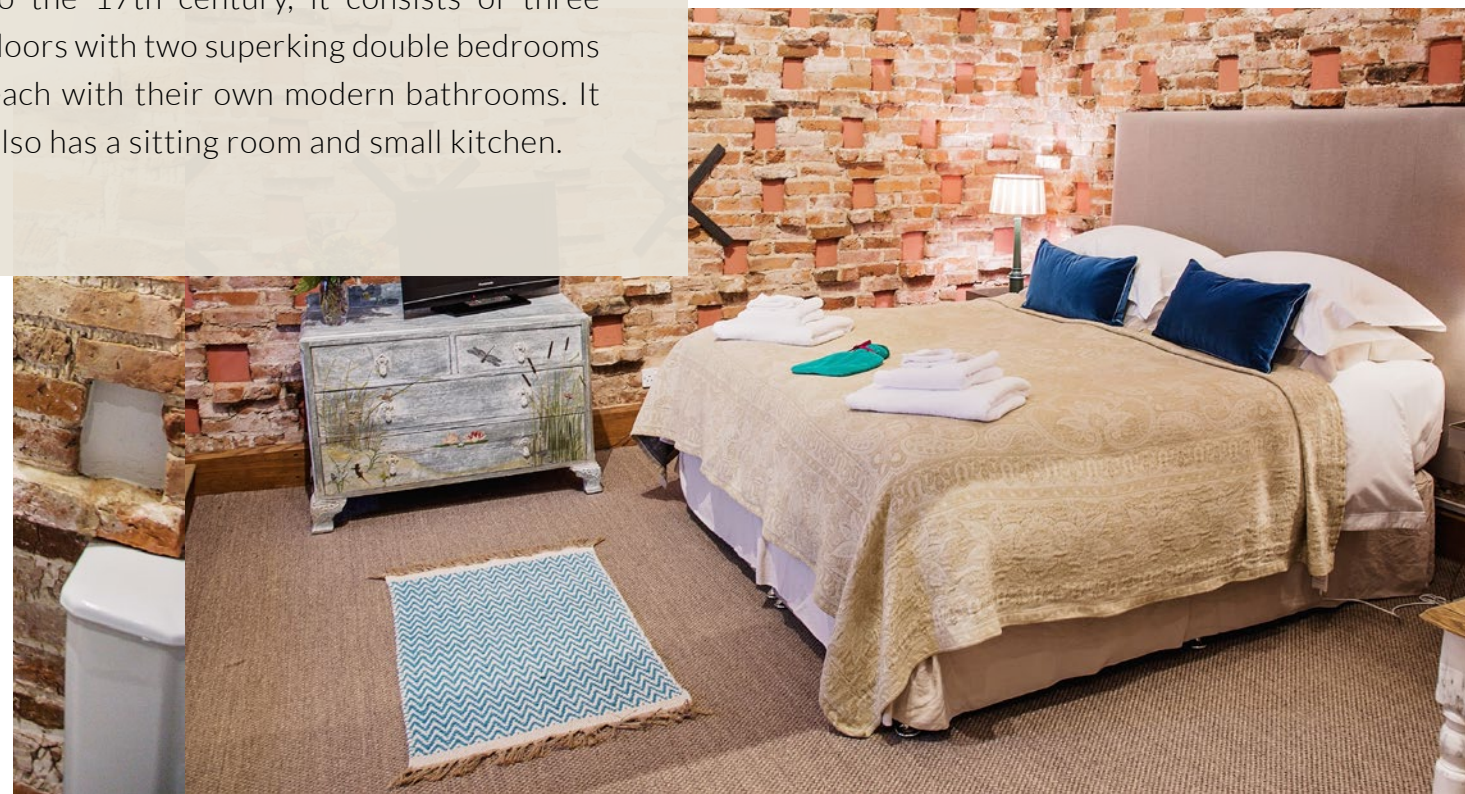
The Bridal Suite is a half timbered Elizabethan wing of Pauntley Court. It has one beautiful vaulted bedroom with an en suite bathroom, an enormous bath and walk in shower. Downstairs there is a kitchen and a sitting room with a woodburner.





The Dovecote

A unique and historical building dating back to the 17th century, it consists of three floors with two superking double bedrooms each with their own modern bathrooms. It also has a sitting room and small kitchen.





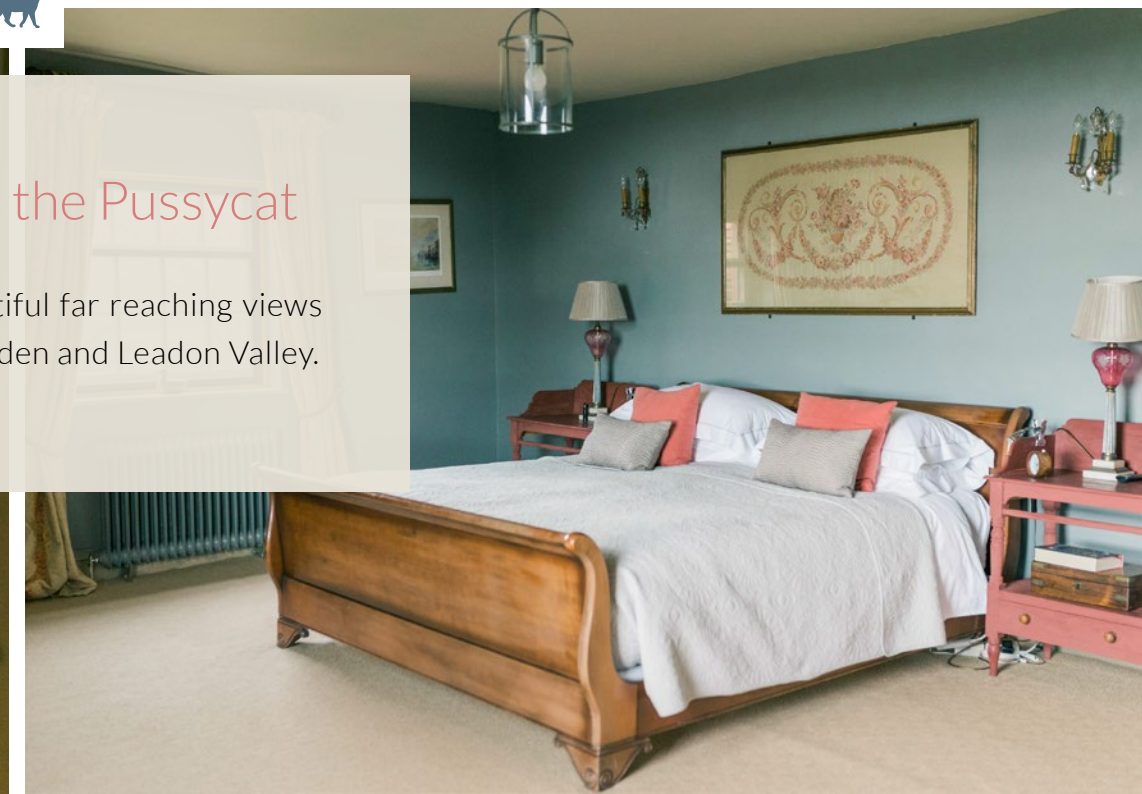
The Wayfarer

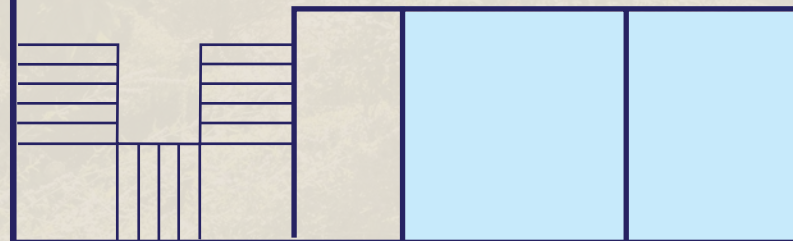

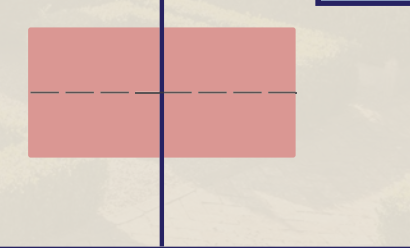
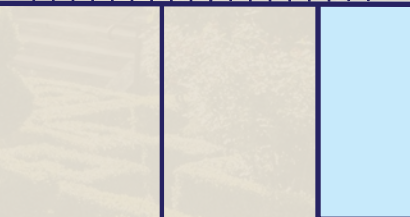

Bedroom layout

The Main House has 7 bedrooms and 6 bathrooms with 4 extra beds and sleeps up to 18 people. Bedroom 8, is in the wing of the house known as Elinor Fettiplace. Bedroom 9 and 10 are in the Dovecote.

Bedroom 1: The Owl and the Pussycat

This is the master bedroom at the top of the main stairs and with beautiful far reaching views over the sunken garden and Leadon Valley beyond. It has a super king sized bed with a big ensuite bathroom with a freestanding bath and walk in shower with underfloor heating. (1a)

Bedroom 2: The Wayfarer

This is next door to the Owl and the Pussycat and is a large south-facing bedroom looking into the courtyard at the front of the house. It has a king sized bed and there is a day bed in this bedroom too. It has its own en suite shower room. (2b)

Bedroom 3: The Somerset

This is next door to the Wayfarer and is a pretty south-facing bedroom looking into the courtyard. It has a king sized sleigh bed and there is a day bed in this bedroom too. This bedroom has its own bathroom opposite off the main landing with a large bath and hand held shower. (3c)

Bedroom 4: The Dick Whittington room

This is at the end of the main landing and is a large bedroom with a super king bed (which can be made into two single beds if required). It has an en suite bathroom with walk in shower. This bedroom has a second door from which you can access the John Masfield bedroom and the second set of private stairs which lead to the John Masfield bedroom. (4d)

Bedroom 5: The John Masfield room

This bedroom is next door to the Dick Whittington room but has its own set of stairs (just for your information these stairs are the back stairs so are steeper than the main stairs). It has a super king sized be which again can be split into single beds. It has an en suite bathroom with a shower over a bath and underfloor heating. (5e)

Bedroom 6: The Stokes room

This bedroom is accessed by a third staircase and has a king sized bed and a single bed in it. It is in the oldest part of the house so has a high ceiling with exposed beams. The bathroom next door has a shower over a bath. (6f)

Bedroom 7: The Riccardo room

This bedroom has a queen sized bed and a single bed and is accessed by the third staircase and shares a bathroom with the Riccardo room. Both Bedroom 6 and 7 can be accessed through a door from Bedroom 3. (6f)

Bedroom 8: Elinor Fettiplace wing

This bedroom has a large superking bed which can be split into singles and an en suite bathroom with a large bath and walk in shower room. Downstairs in the sitting room is a sofa bed and a downstairs loo. There is also a kitchen and the wing has its own separate entrance from the Flower room.

Bedroom 9 & 10 : The Dovecote

The Dovecote has two further bedrooms, both with super king beds which can be split into singles and both with en suite bathrooms.
