





Our Heritage

Your guests will follow you out into the beautifully-tiered terraced gardens for a celebratory glass of champagne.










The Orangery

A magical place to dine and dance the night away, our stunning newly appointed glass orangery and terrace are a creative salute to the theatrical entertainment style of the Gatsby era. Truly private and available for exclusive use only, it has capacity for 160 seated guests in addition to a dance floor, cloakroom, and luxury washrooms. It includes its own fully incorporated kitchen for all fine dining requirements, as well as the option to add additional marquees or a food station on the adjoining lawn.









The Mansion

For more intimate gatherings of up to 50 guests, we offer use of the mansion drawing rooms and terraces. Built in 1913 by architects Sir Herbert Baker and Philip Tilden, the Cape Dutch-style mansion is surrounded by 14 acres of landscaped terraced gardens, providing the perfect backdrop for those special moments. The strikingly original décor is enhanced yet more by lovely sea views from the south and west facing terraces.










Moroccan Courtyard

The Moroccan courtyard, tucked away on the mansion's first floor, was the inner heart of the party for Sassoon's many influential friends during the Great Gatsby era of the 20s and 30s.

Sensitively restored in 2019, the original marble columns and floors are complemented by antique brass lanterns, tinkling water fountains and pastel pink walls draped in scented jasmine and bougainvillea.

Exclusive use of the Moroccan Courtyard and adjoining Courtyard Suite provides the perfect setting for rehearsal dinners, cocktail evenings, wedding party receptions and ceremonies of up to 24 guests.

Safari & Animal Encounters


Wildlife conservation is at the heart of all we do.

During your stay, guests are free to roam the 600 acre reserve and learn about all the incredible species we protect. With over 900 animals under our care, there is plenty for all to enjoy.

Private guided safaris and animal encounters can be arranged for you and your guests, creating perfect moments for a wedding album to rival scenes from Out of Africa.

Working with our sister charity The Aspinall Foundation, we have released over 320 endangered animals back to the wild, including 8 black rhino, 135 primates, 11 European bison, 5 cheetah and over 70 western lowland gorillas.

By hosting your wedding with us, you will be supporting our conservation work, actively helping to ensure the future of these endangered species.




The Courtyard Suite

HOW TO REACH US

Port Lympne Hotel & Reserve is located in the South East of England in the beautiful county of Kent, and is within easy reach of London, Surrey, Sussex, and Essex.

By Car:

Take Junction 11 off the M20 and follow the brown tourism signs to the park.

By Train

Ashford International is 15 mins away and provides high speed rail services to London St Pancras (40 min) and Paris (1.5 hours).

By Air

Both Gatwick & Heathrow Airports are within a 1.5 hour drive. For those wishing to arrive by helicopter we have our own helipad onsite.
