Dear Valued Customer:

California's Proposition 65 warning regulations have changed effective August 30, 2018.

As part of our Proposition 65 compliance program some of our products will bear Proposition 65 warnings to be in compliance with the new regulations.

The attached current list of products will have to be labeled for your California customers with a Proposition 65 warning label for items manufactured on or after August 30, 2018. To assist you in complying we will provide you with the appropriate label upon request.

This list may still be updated from time to time. These listed products should have the following new "short-form" Proposition warning on the product label:

If you sell any of these listed products on your website, you must also provide a warning to all California purchasers. The warning may be provided by including the warning on the product display page, by a clearly marked hyperlink using the word "WARNING" on the product display page, or by otherwise prominently displaying the warning to the purchaser prior to the purchaser completing the purchase. (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 27, § 25602 (b).) The warning should be identical to and use the same Proposition 65 warning language that is on our product label.

It is your responsibility to make sure that your website is in compliance with the new Proposition 65 warning requirements for internet sales. You may want to consult with your own legal counsel, as needed, to determine whether your website complies with the new regulatory requirements for Proposition 65 warnings.
