Point Name: 大迎 (dà yíng) "Great Welcome"

Meridian: Stomach

Element: Earth

Polarity: Yang

Peak Time: 7AM to 9AM

Location

Anterior to the angle of the mandible, on the anterior border of the attached portion of muscle masseter, in the groove like depression appearing when the cheek is bulged or 0.5 cun below Jiache (ST-6), a groove appears when the mouth is closed tight and the cheeks are blown.

Local Anatomy: Anterior to the angle of the mandible, on the anterior border of the masseter muscle, in the groove like depression appearing when the cheek is bulged 0.5 cun anterior to ST-6.

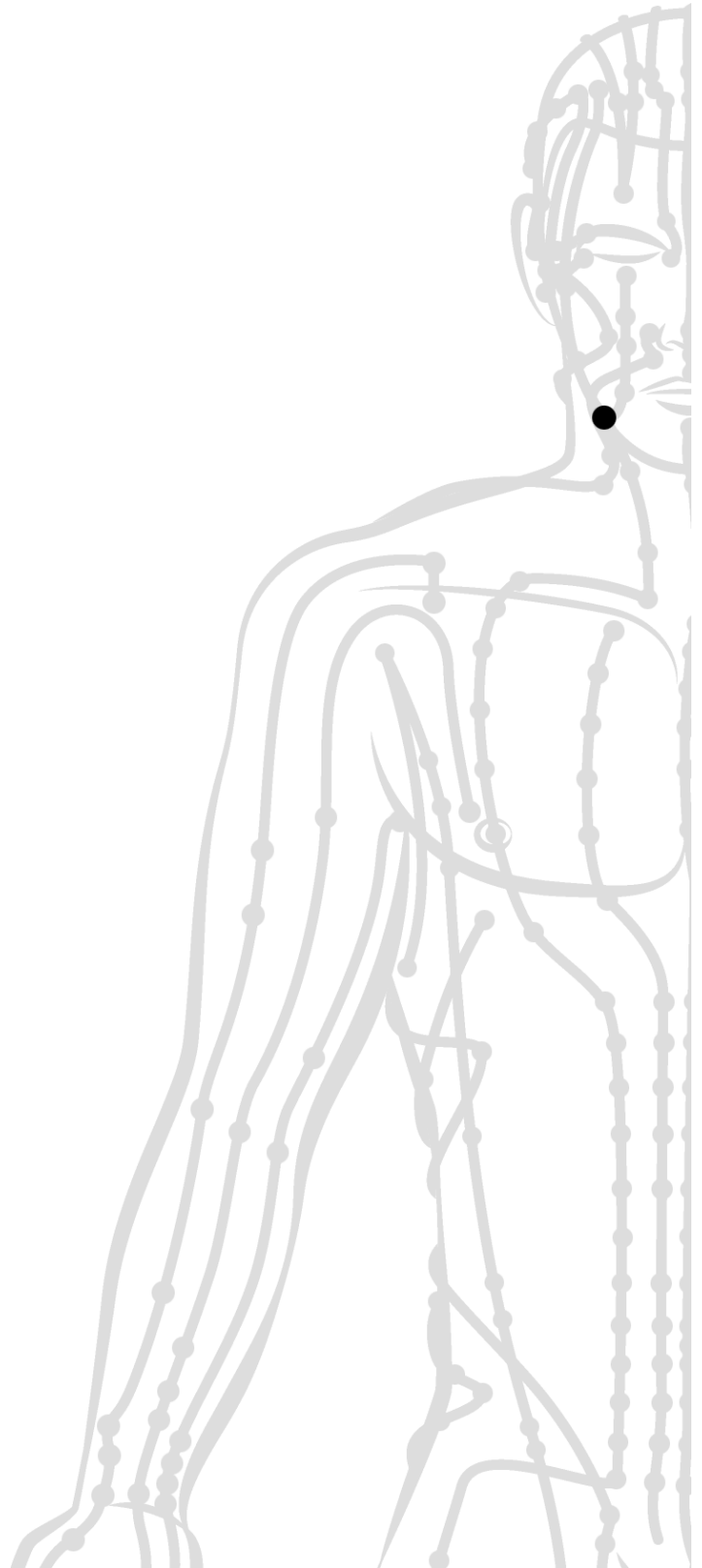
Vasculature: The facial artery and vein.

Innervation: The facial and buccal nerves.

- Intersection Point of the Gall Bladder Meridian
- Meeting of the Stomach with the Liver Divergent Meridian

- Trigger Point of the Masseter muscle

Attack Method: Obliquely 0.3 - 0.5 inch. Slanted insertion 0.5 - 0.8 inch. Don't puncture the artery. Angle is 15°.

Description

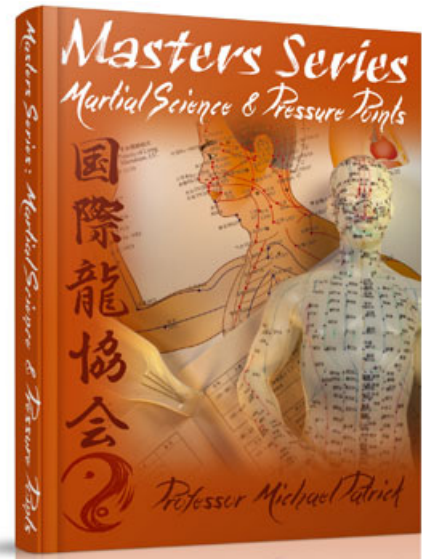
A strike to the jaw here will disrupt the brain and can cause dizziness and confusion. Strikes here are able to send a lot of Yang Qi into the brain.

A medium power strike may result in knock out while a more powerful strike can break the jaw.

This point is also associated with ST-9 by way of ST-1 and ST-8. Its correlation with ST-9 will cause knock out via the carotid sinus stopping the blood pressure. Moreover, there are vagus nerve endings that enter the base of the stomach.
