# Lessons From Habakkuk

Have you ever talked to God and as soon as you got done, you felt like you were fake with God? I have experienced this in my life, and I know how silly you feel afterward. God does not want us to be fake with Him. I mean, He knows our every thought. I want to tell you about one of God's prophets who had no problem at all being real with God - Habakkuk. Habakkuk has some doubts and questions that he wants to bring before God and this Book is excellent for us to see that God listens to His faithful servants. Internally, Habakkuk saw violence, lawbreaking, and injustice go unpunished, so he questioned God about it. I think very often, we can be a lot like Habakkuk, and that is okay! Things happen in this world, and we cannot comprehend why they happen, so we ask God. Habakkuk very visibly wants God's help. He realizes that he cannot do this on his own and needs to know that God is near. We are going to see 2 lessons we can learn from Habakkuk and apply them to our lives.

Lesson #1 - The righteous will live by faith - 2:4. God knows who His people are by the way that they are living their lives. Throughout the entire history of the world, God has had people who lived by faith, and those who did not. God always rewards those who live by faith. For example, Noah was able to live while God destroyed the whole world because he lived by faith. Faith is the courage for any crisis. Are you in the valley of fear, or on the mountain of faith? God wants us to be standing on the mountain of faith! He wants us to be telling others about our great faith in Him and that He is willing to work in their life. The righteous will live by faith.

Lesson #2 - God never ignores a sincere questioner - 1:5-11. Having questions is okay. It is okay to not have a complete grasp on things. However, there is someone who has an answer to everything, and He wants to hear your questions! Habakkuk comes off as an extreme fashion that we would be hesitant to use, but this shows how real Habakkuk is with God. There are times when we are angry, sad, or heartbroken, and we want an answer. If we are sincere in bringing these things to God and remember that He is going to take care of us, He is going to answer those prayers. God never ignores a sincere questioner, and He always wants to talk to His children.
