LISA EDWARDS

Lisa began training at the age of 5 at The Dance Academy in her hometown of Dubbo, NSW, Australia. Lisa graduated from the Australian Ballet School in 1999 and pursued a career in Europe. During her 4 years in Europe Lisa danced with the Stadttheater St Gallen in Switzerland, Anhaltisches Theater Dessau and Stadttheater Koblenz in Germany and toured throughout Europe, Cuba and Croatia.

Lisa moved back to Australia in 2004 to join the Queensland Ballet Company under the directorship of Francois Klaus and appeared in all productions within Australia and many Asia Pacific tours. Artistic Director Li Cunxin took over in 2013 and promptly promoted Lisa Soloist in 2013, and then Senior Soloist in 2016. Lisa retired from stage at the end of 2018.

EMILIO PAVAN

Born in 1993 in Newcastle, Australia, Emilio Pavan began his dance training at the Newcastle Dance Academy before furthering his studies at the prestigious Australian Ballet School in Melbourne at the age of 16. Upon graduating, he joined Queensland Ballet in 2013, where his exceptional artistry and technique quickly earned him a promotion to Junior Soloist in 2014, following his acclaimed performance as Franz in Coppélia.

In 2015, Emilio joined the English National Ballet in London as a Soloist, where he continued to refine his craft and expand his repertoire. Two years later, in 2017, he became a Soloist with the Bayerisches Staatsballett, one of Europe's leading ballet companies. His remarkable performances led to a promotion to First Soloist the following season, and in September 2019, he achieved the company's highest rank, Principal Dancer.

Throughout his career, Emilio has worked with some of the world's most renowned choreographers and has performed internationally as a guest artist with top ballet companies. His versatility, technical brilliance, and commanding stage presence have established him as a distinguished figure in the world of classical ballet.

After retiring at the end of the 2023 season, Emilio returned to Australia to peruse his passion for teaching and passing on his extensive knowledge to the next generation of stars.

She has danced as a company artist with The Australian Ballet and Sydney Dance Company, touring extensively throughout Australia, Europe, the UK, the USA, South America and New Zealand. In 2011 she was awarded an Ian Potter Cultural Trust Grant to undertake artistic development in Europe and India. Her performance repertoire is vast and includes works by George Balanchine, Rudolph Nureyev, Krzysztof Pastor, Kenneth McMillan, Stanton Welsh, Rafael Bonachela, Graeme Murphy, Stephanie Lake, Alexander Ekman, Gideon Obarzanek, Lee Serle, Gabrielle Nankivell, Alice Topp and Jacopo Godani. In 2023 she performed as a guest artist with The Australian Ballet as part of their 60th birthday celebration seasons in Melbourne and Sydney. She also collaborated Yuiko Masukawa in creation and performance of her work "Yugen" for Frame festival in Melbourne. She is committed to honesty and sustainability in her relationship to environment, community and history through the expressive capacity the body and approaches dancing as medium for embodied presence offering endless possibilities for intimacy, freedom and human connection.
