Welcome to the 2025/2026 Dance Season!

We're excited to open PRIORITY REGISTRATION on June 2, 2025.

RECREATIONAL STUDENTS

Because our recreational classes fill quickly, we're offering priority registration to returning 2024/2025 students before opening to the public.

We'll be using this year's schedule as a framework for 2025/2026, with finalized class times released closer to our September start date.

FESTIVAL & COMPETITIVE STUDENTS

Register for the styles you're interested in, no need to select a level. Once registration is complete, we'll group dancers by age, experience, and skill. This allows us to finalize the schedule sooner and ensure dancers are placed in the best-fit classes.

HELPFUL TIP

If your dancer is unsure about a style, we recommend registering anyway! It's much easier for us to remove a dancer than to add one later. If you withdraw before September, we're happy to issue a refund or credit.

WHAT'S NEW FOR 2025/2026

A. Multi-Class Discount Tuition Structure

We've implemented a new tuition model that rewards students who take multiple classes:

1st class: Full Price

2nd class: 7% off

3rd class: 12% off

4th class and beyond: 15% off each

Each class is discounted based on its rank in a dancer's weekly

schedule. For example, a dancer taking 3 classes would pay:

Full price for the 1st class

7% off the 2nd

12% off the 3rd

These discounts are applied automatically.

B. Mandatory Technique Class – Westland Skills Lab (Level 4+5 Only)

Mandatory Technique Class for Level 4 and 5: All Level 4 and 5 dancers registered in Jazz, Ballet, Tap, Lyrical, or Acro are now required to take our new 1-hour weekly technique class: Westland Skills Lab. **This class will be optional for Level 2 & 3 dancers in Rocky.**

This foundational class is designed to elevate our dancers' technique across all genres and includes rotating modules in ballet, jumps, turns, flexibility, strength & conditioning, and more.

- No costume or choreography fees
- No registration fee
- Does not perform or compete

Flat Rate: \$55/month per dancer or \$495 if paid in full by September 1st.

Westland Skills Lab is your dancer's weekly powerhouse hour building strength, refining technique, and training smarter for the stage. This is where the behind-the-scenes magic happens.



C. Festival Class Length Extended

Festival classes will now run 55 minutes weekly to give dancers more time to refine technique, practice choreography, build confidence and teamwork. This update gives students a stronger foundation and better prepares them for festival performances.

Festival students perform at Alberta-based festivals and receive an award of completion without being ranked or scored against others, perfect for new dance families!

D. New! Contemporary Large Group Class

We're introducing a brand new Contemporary Large Group for the 2025/2026 season!

- Open to all dancers already enrolled in Lyrical
- Will attend competitions and require choreography & costume fees

E. Updated Prerequisites for Level 2+ Competitive Classes

To ensure dancers are technically prepared, the following prerequisites apply:

Updated Prerequisites for Level 2+ Competitive Classes:

- Lyrical: Must also take Ballet or Jazz
- Contemporary: Must also take Lyrical
- Acro-dance: Must also take Ballet, Jazz, or Hip Hop
- Variety/Musical Theatre: Must also take Ballet, Jazz, or Hip Hop
- Hip Hop: No prerequisites required

PRICING AND PAYMENTS

NEW

Multi-Class Discount Tuition Structure: We've implemented a new tuition structure that offers discounts based on the number of classes taken per dancer:

1st class: Full Price

2nd class: 7% off

3rd class: 12% off

4th class and beyond: 15% off each

This structure rewards dancers who take multiple disciplines while still ensuring we can maintain program quality. Each class is calculated individually using its position in the class order. These discounts are applied automatically and reflected in the totals listed in the tuition chart.

Note: The Westland Skills Lab is a flat monthly rate and is not included in the class discount structure.

TUITION BILLING & PAYMENT

- Tuition is billed monthly from September 1 to May 1, with equal payments each month regardless of holidays or the number of classes in a month.
- Registration and PREF fees are due at the time of sign-up.
 These are non-refundable and secure your dancer's spot in class.
- Tuition is automatically withdrawn on the 1st of each month using the payment method provided at registration.
- Enrollment in autopay with a debit or credit card is mandatory unless you are planning to pay your tuition in full for the entire 2025/2026 season.
- Short-term sessional classes do not require autopay enrollment.
- A late fee will be applied to any payments not completed by the 15th of the month.
- There are no refunds on tuition or fees at any time. If you wish
 to discontinue classes, you must complete our official
 withdrawal form before the 1st of the upcoming month to
 avoid being charged for the next month's tuition.
- If your payment information changes, please update your account promptly to avoid interruption in classes.

WHAT IS THE WESTLAND SKILLS LAB AND WHY IS IT REQUIRED FOR LEVEL 4 & 5 DANCERS?

Westland Skills Lab is a one hour weekly technique class designed to build stronger, more versatile dancers by focusing on core skills that support all styles of dance. Through rotating modules, dancers train in ballet technique, strength and conditioning, flexibility, Acro foundations, jazz turns and jumps, and cross-training all in one powerful class.

This class does not replace your dancer's regular style-based classes like jazz, ballet, or lyrical. It enhances them. Dancers will still take their regular classes to learn choreography, explore artistic expression, and prepare for performances. Skills Lab gives them the technical edge to execute those routines with confidence, control, and strength.

At many other studios, dancers are required to take separate technique classes for each discipline. Westland Skills Lab gives our students access to that same level of well-rounded training in a more efficient and accessible way without requiring a packed schedule of multiple technique blocks.

Quick facts:

- Required for Level 4 & 5 dancers taking Jazz, Ballet, Tap,
 Lyrical or Acro. The class is optional for level 2 & 3 dancers.
 - One hour per week focused solely on technique (no choreography or performances)
 - Not eligible for multi-class discounts
