Our fitted-out academy premises are designed to provide a comfortable, professional & nurturing platform, and the foundation to support your child's first steps in the journey to success in the Performing Arts. The Chadwick Studios facility accommodates multiple age groups, skill levels & performance styles such as Jazz, Tap, Ballet, Lyrical, Contemporary, Hip-Hop, Acrobatics, Singing, Musical Theatre, Aerial Silks, Competition Teams, Solos, Toddler Classes and more...!

Our dedicated staff have been trained at very high levels in their chosen dance styles, and possess multiple qualifications, including a Working With Children Blue Card. They provide a warm, welcoming and professional environment for students to develop to their full potential, are very approachable, and aim to make your family feel welcome every single step of the way!

## PARTICIPATION

We recommend students maintain consistency by attending all their enrolled classes to get the most out of their dance journey. Consistency will allow your children to grow and develop as dancers and performers. Missing classes can result in the possibility a student may be repositioned or replaced within the routine based on rehearsal progress. Please advise front desk staff if your child is going to be away from any classes.

## IMPORTANT INFORMATION

All enquiries or concerns are to go through the front counter staff. Please regularly check your emails for updates and announcements. If you require any changes or updates to your personal details, please advise front counter staff.

## ENROLMENT AND 7 DAY FREE CLASS PASS

New families can try a 7-day free class pass to explore different styles and meet our teachers before committing. After the trial, enrolment is completed online via our Dance Portal, including forms for consent, waiver, and class registration. Enrolments continue each term automatically, and invoices are issued at the end of each term. Payment is required before commencement.

## DANCE PORTAL

Our Parent Dance Portal makes it easy to register for classes, manage payments, view your child's schedule, and stay up to date with studio news. To claim your 7-Day Free Class Pass, simply create an account, add your dancer, and schedule a trial the portal will only display classes suited to your child's ages.

## **DANCE PROGRAMS**

We offer programs for all dancers, whether for fun, fitness, or performance.

### Tiny Tots (2-5 years)

A 22-week program focused on fun, movement, rhythm and building coordination. Classes are on Wednesday & Saturday mornings.

### Creative Program (5+ years)

Explore dance without competition. Includes Jazz, Ballet, Tap, Hip Hop, Contemporary, Stretch, KTL, Acropop, Musical Theatre, Tap, Technique, Aerial/Silks & Acrobatics. Flexible, fun, and great for fitness and life skills.

Age Groups: 5-8 | 9-12 | Pre-Senior 9-14 | Senior 14+ | Open 16+

### Performance Ensemble

For students aiming to join our elite performance team. Full attendance required. Training includes Jazz, Ballet, Contemporary, Hip Hop, Tap, Acrobatics, Musical Theatre, Drama, Singing, Competition Prep, rehearsals and industry insight.

## **PERFORMANCE ENSEMBLE AUDITIONS**

All students wishing to join the Performance Ensemble must audition, usually held in October each year. Attending as an unlimited student prior to audition allows dancers to train across multiple classes and gain confidence before being assessed. Preparation includes consistent attendance at classes and rehearsals. Auditions help Megan place students in the team that best suits their abilities, ensuring every dancer is set up for success.

## **CHADWICK BALLET METHOD**

Our Ballet program is designed for the modern dancer. Our aim is to bring out the best in every dancer through a bespoke syllabus created by Megan Chadwick. Combining classical ballet tradition with modern teaching techniques, the program focuses on strength, technique, musicality, and expression. Classes are age-appropriate and progress step-by-step, from beginners learning first positions to advanced dancers preparing for pointe work. With 8 levels of progression, our method builds strong foundations, confidence, and a love for ballet, while celebrating every milestone along the way.

## **CHADWICK ACADEMY & PART-TIME (Homeschool)**

Our Chadwick Academy combines performing arts with a strong focus on creativity, health, and wellness. Students are given the opportunity to grow as dancers and performers while developing important life skills in a supportive environment. The program follows a balanced structure of dance training, creative and artistic activities, and music, designed to nurture both personal growth and artistic expression.

Our Academy days are Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday 8:30am - 2:30pm at \$60 a day with academy students allowed to stay on for the evening classes at no extra cost.

For families seeking a lighter option, the Part-Time program is available on Mondays only also at \$60 a day and is open to all ages.

- Boys Ballet: Black leotard with black leggings, black crew socks, black canvas ballet shoes

## Competitions and Events

Students representing Chadwick Studios at competitions, workshops or events must wear the studio uniform.

## Hair

Hair needs to be neatly pulled back with a hair tie. All ballet students are required to have a neat bun & slicked back with hairspray.

Will need to be purchased directly with a dance store.

## STUDIO TO SPOTLIGHT - PERFORMANCES & EVENTS

Chadwick Studios Performances allow students to showcase their progress, build confidence, and experience the thrill of performing on stage. Creative and Tiny Tots students are welcome to participate, though it is optional. Rehearsals are compulsory for all participants to ensure students are prepared, confident Extra charges including uniform, costumes and ticket purchases are additional to the terms tuition.

Please note Tiny Tots only Perform in our End of Year Show.

## CONCERT FEES

Mid-Year Event Chadwick Studios | In house workshop

- Registration \$65 per dance (2026 prices only \*subject to changes\*)
- Uniform prices are \$120 for the set (2026 prices only \*subject to changes\*) depending on what items are needed.

End-of-Year Concert

- Concert Package Fee: \$75
- Costume Fees: Vary depending on the genre or style, typically \$120-\$150 each.

Both events are ticketed separately, and ticket costs are not included in the fees above.

## **DANCE TUITION**

Tuition is paid per term through our Online Dance Portal. A \$45 annual membership fee covers insurance. All fees are non-refundable for missed or discontinued classes. Tuition is due the first day of the term via Auto-Pay and late payments may incur an administration fee. Optional extras such as additional rehearsals, workshops, or costumes are invoiced separately.

## **AUTO-PAY**

Auto-Payments are our secure system for processing tuition fees, with payments automatically charged to your saved card on the first day of each term. From 2026 onward, all tuition will be paid this way, ensuring a simple, reliable, and hassle-free process for families.

Log into your parent portal, go to the Pay dropdown, and select Auto-pay to set up automatic payments.

A convenience fee is an additional charge set by the merchant services, not Chadwick Studios, to cover the cost of processing electronic or card payments.

## FOOD AND DRINK POLICY

Our focus on fundamentals, flexibility, technique and ballet, combined with our extensive program will ensure your child has the greatest opportunity to advance their skills as a performer. Aside from this we also want to clearly state our values and goals for the studio so that we don't lose sight of the things that also matter to us.

Our goal is to create an environment for children to feel safe so that they are able to express themselves freely through dance with utmost enjoyment. Feeling supported in self confidence, learning, technique & creativity from both teachers & their peers.

To keep a high standard of self-discipline, professionalism and respect, having respect for their fellow classmates, teachers and staff members. Listening to instructions by teachers and learning to support others. Always giving your best and striving to be better. Never stop learning, never stop growing regardless of your ability level. It is also vital that we are also respecting the studio as a whole by arriving to class ready, on time & in the correct uniform. Participating in all compulsory rehearsals & classes set out by the studio as well as anything that is required if you are a part of the Performance Ensemble program.

We want to help your children to build friendships, create lasting memories, and instill high level performance skills and the ability to choose their path in life. Learning to be clean and respectful will help student's lives both at the studio & outside of dance. We are dedicated to providing a comfortable, professional and nurturing platform, and the foundation to support your child's first steps in the journey to success in the performing arts. We hope to create a standard of values that they can use later in life but most of all, a place to have fun, and a positive studio for everyone to enjoy.

### STUDIO POLICY

- We do not interrupt classes after they have commenced.
- Water ONLY is allowed in the studios. Other food, drinks, soft drinks and chewing gum are prohibited.
- Children must be supervised at all times, and are not free to run around the waiting room nor classroom areas. We love babies and young children and appreciate the chance to meet our students' siblings, however our priority is the safety of every child on the school premises.
- No mobile phones, tablets or computers are permitted to be used during class time, unless the teacher specifies that it is for education purposes.
- All communication with teachers regarding matters involving Chadwick Studios must go through the front counter staff, either directly, by phone or email.
- While we accept that genuine concerns need to be raised and resolved, gossip and rumours are considered unacceptable behaviour and reflect badly on everyone. All students are to behave professionally towards fellow students as well as those from other studios, displaying a supportive attitude and kindness to others in the spirit of the performing arts.
- Students must show respect for their teachers and other students at all times. Inappropriate behaviour could result in dismissal from the school.
- Hair is to be pulled up and off the neck and face (except in Hip Hop). No jewellery is to be worn in class, other than ear studs or sleepers, for safety reasons.
- Smoking is strictly PROHIBITED on the premises at all times.
- Alcohol is strictly PROHIBITED on the premises during times when children are, or are likely, to be present.
- Belongings and valuables should not be left unattended. The studio takes no responsibility for lost items left in the waiting rooms, hallways and bathrooms. Pigeonholes are provided in the stretch and change room for students to place personal items during classes.
- Filming and photography in class is only permitted if formal consent has been granted by Chadwick Studios. The Privacy of every student is protected by law, and all of our classes and programs are protected by Copyright; recorded footage MUST NOT be shared in public nor on any social media.
