Participation Commitment

Important Dates

- **Feb 5:** Last day to decline participation ([Opt-Out Form](#))
- **Feb 9:** Concert & Costume fees posted
- **Feb 10:** Costume sizing form due
- **Feb 16:** Concert & costume fees auto-processed
- **Feb 17:** Late fee applied to unpaid balances
- **Feb 25:** Final payment deadline

Additional Dates (subject to change):

- **May 4:** Priority ticket sales begin
- **May 11:** General ticket sales
- **May 16:** Costume pickup day

Spring Concert Fees

Concert Fee (*includes venue rental, insurance, production costs, concert video access, commemorative t-shirt, and participation medal*)

- 1st Student: **\$175**
- 2nd Student: **\$105**
- 3rd Student: **\$50**

Costume Fees

(All costumes include a labeled garment bag & hanger. Tights and shoes purchased separately.)

- **SOAR (Ages 3–5):** \$70 per class
(SOAR combo classes perform one Spring dance – Jazz or Tap)
- **Enrichment & YAA (Ages 5–18):** \$75 per class

Costume Sizing (New This Season)

All participating students must complete a **Costume Size Google Form**, which includes instructions for at-home measuring and size selection guidance. We will purchase costumes based on this form.

- Form sent: **February 2**
- Form due: **February 10**

If the form is not submitted, NAOD will not be responsible for costumes that do not fit.

Tickets

- All guests must purchase tickets
- Reserved, tiered seating: **\$20–\$30** (plus service fee)
- Children **3 and under** may sit on a lap for free
- A ticket is required if a child needs their own seat

Policies & Reminders

- Verbal or student-delivered opt-out notices will not be accepted
- The **Opt-Out Form** is the only approved method to decline participation
- Concert and costume fees are **non-refundable**, even if the form is submitted after payment
- If the form is not submitted by the deadline, participation will be assumed and fees charged
- Withdrawals after payment are not eligible for refunds or credits; purchased items will remain available for pickup
