MOUNT HOPE BLOOD DRIVE

Mount Hope's Blood Drive is on **Tuesday, September 20th**, 3:00-7:00 p.m. Many previous regular donors are no longer able to give blood, so we need "new blood"! If you've been turned down from giving blood due to a low iron count, include a 65 mg. iron supplement and a 1000 mg. Vitamin C (taken at the same time) daily starting now. You should also include iron-rich foods in your diet often, such as red meat, pork and poultry, seafood, beans, dark green leafy vegetables, dried fruit (raisins and apricots), iron-fortified cereals, breads, pastas, peas.
