A Word from Pastor Christy

I invite you as you get back into your routine from your Summer time activities to come and invite someone to join in Worship. This Sunday, August 5th, we will be looking at A Disciple's life according to what Jesus taught in the Beatitudes found in Matthew 5: 9-10 and receive communion at each service.

Perhaps the meaning of beatitude may become clearer to us if it is compared with its opposite. The opposite of beatitude is misery. Misery means being afflicted unwillingly with painful sufferings."

A Disciple's Life is marked by certain characteristics and traits. Jesus taught His Disciples then and now encouraging them and us to embody those laid out in the Sermon on the Mount in Matthew's gospel and the Sermon on the Plain in Luke's gospel.

How fitting it will be this Sunday to come to the altar, receive communion, and let God search our hearts to see what traits and characteristics are reflective of a True Disciple of Jesus Christ in our own life: poor in spirit, mournful, meek, hungry and thirsty for God's filling, merciful, pure in heart, peacemaker, and persecuted because of righteousness.
