A Word from Pastor Christy

Intentional Invitation:

John 1: 40 – “Andrew, Simon Peter’s brother, was one of the two who heard what John had said and who had followed Jesus. The first thing Andrew did was to find his brother Simon and tell him, ‘We have found the Messiah’ (that is the Christ). And he (Andrew) brought him (Simon Peter) to Jesus.”

When was the last time YOU intentionally invited someone to Worship, Bible Study, a gathering or program in or through the Church?

Church invitation is more common than one may think. According to an article in International Faith, nearly two thirds of Protestant churchgoers say they have invited at least one person to visit their church in the past six months.

- 17% - say they extended an invitation.
- 21% - say they extended two invitations.
- 25% - say they extended three or more invitations.

However,

- 29% - say they did not invite anyone.
- 43% - United Methodists say they have not invited anyone. (And, this is varied in different parts of the United States)

So, why don’t people invite others to join them?

- 31% - say I don’t know why
- 20% - say people have refused their invitation
- 17% - say they don’t know anyone to invite
- 11% - say they are not comfortable inviting someone to church.

We are intentional about whom we invite to our home for activities and meals. We are intentional about whom we invite to the wedding, baby – wedding shower, and today even at times funeral services.

It takes each of us to say: if you don’t have a church home, I invite you to join me at Cairo First UMC and I will come by your house and pick you up, I will meet you in the parking lot, I will take you out to lunch or have you in my home for lunch following the service or activity.

So, Church – Say to someone whom God has placed on your heart and mind, Come and See Jesus @ Cairo First UMC.

Pray daily for the ongoing ministry and mission of Cairo First UMC. As well pray for each Sunday’s services and for Your Pastor, Staff, Ministries, Missions, and Volunteer Leaders of the Cairo First UMC.
