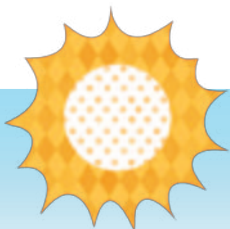

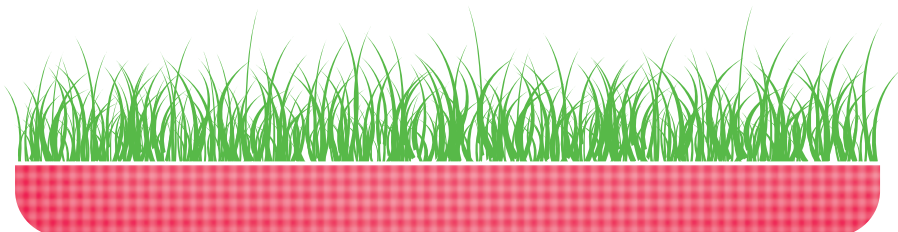

CHURCH NIGHT SUPPERS:

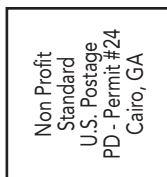
