A Word from Pastor Christy

Sanctuary Renovation

The Laity Council members, Trustees, Finance Committee members and the Building Committee met Thursday, October 1, 2020 on the renovation of the sanctuary.

The Building Committee presented a plan which includes:

- Refinishing the existing pews \$32,000
- Sand and seal existing heart pine floors \$15,000
- Repaint Sanctuary \$15,000
- Update the lighting \$10,000
- Carpet Runners \$10,000
- Work Comp and Supervisors cost \$10,000
- Contingency \$10,000

Total estimated cost: \$102,000

Following the building committee's recommendation, the Trustee Chair Robert Hudson stated that the Trustees were rescinding their previous recommendation as more options and information have been received.

A motion was made to accept the building committee's recommendation. Motion was accepted unanimously to proceed.

The plan is to begin work on October 12th and the goal is to complete the project in time for a Christmas program. This is an aggressive goal, but we will work hard to achieve it.

Let's all pull together to use this project to help build unity within Our Church.
