SANCTUARY RENOVATION:

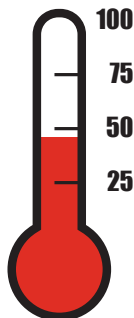
The work on the sanctuary renovation is underway, but we need everyone’s support financially to cover this project.
