The Shepherd Family—from Henry, Tennessee—performs and leads worship across the southeast! Featured regularly on Tennessee Public Television's *Gospel Music Showcase*, and leading worship for the both the North Carolina and Tennessee Baptist Convention, the family has emerged with a reputation for skillful instrumental arrangements and rich vocal harmonies across a vast array of musical styles—including bluegrass, folk, classical, traditional, contemporary Christian and more!



The four siblings are scholarship students in the pre-college program at Vanderbilt University's Blair School of Music. Fifteen-year-old Jordan (mandolin, viola, guitar, and vocals) serves as Worship Leader at New Harmony Baptist Church in Paris, TN, and is the assistant conductor of Vanderbilt University's Curb Youth Symphony.

Twelve year-old Iris is equally skilled at classical violin and fiddle, winning the Samuel Fordis Young Artist Concerto Competition and the James G. "Bobo" Driver National Championship fiddle contest. In February of 2018, she will be a featured soloist with the Georgia Philharmonic Orchestra. Jordan and Iris made their Grand Ole Opry stage debuts during the summer of 2016, performing featured solos as part of the Fine Arts Summer Academy. The family is rounded out with 10-year-old Gideon (cello and banjo), and 8-year-old Grace (violin and vocals), who was adopted from China in 2014.

Traci, a homeschool mom and wedding photographer, sings with the family. Scott (Worship and Music Specialist with the Tennessee Baptist Mission Board and adjunct faculty member at Union University) arranges the family's music, sings, and plays piano and guitar.

Concert will begin at 5:00 PM-Evangelism Rally begins at 6:00 PM. We will have a combined choir; practice will be at 4:30 in the choir room at FBC, Dandridge. Harry House will be leading the choir.

Human Trafficking Survivor, Best Selling Author, Victim's Advocate, Founder of S.O.A.P. (Save Our Adolescents from Prostitution), Consultant.

Ms. Flores has been a licensed Social Worker for over twenty years. She received a Master's in Counseling Education from the University of Dayton and a Bachelor's of Social Work from Ball State University. She was appointed to the Ohio Attorney General's Human Trafficking Commission in 2009 and has testified before the Ohio House and Senate in support of Human Trafficking Legislation. Her efforts were a major part of the success of these bills being passed into laws. Additionally, the **"Theresa Flores Law"** was passed in Michigan that eliminates the statute of limitation for children who have been trafficked.

Christian Resource Outreach Serving the Savior


Cross Ministries
