### Greetings Church!

Before I begin, I have to say once again, how amazed I am at your generosity. When the call went out a few weeks ago about the shortfall in our

finances for the year, I could not imagine that we would be able to meet our budget. Your faithfulness in being good stewards reflects your love for this church and for God. I thank you and I commend you all for your generosity and faith.

It is hard to believe that we are into March and Lent. As we travel this Lenten pathway toward Easter, I will be preaching a sermon series called, *Meeting Jesus at the Table*. In the Gospels, especially in the Gospel of Luke, we find Jesus very often eating and drinking. In his day, sharing a meal with someone communicated many things. Women didn't eat with men, other than their husbands in their homes. Social classes never mixed around the table. The very religious of the

day would not sit at a table with those who were ritually unclean. Dinner parties were a really big deal that, if invited, could boost your status or if uninvited could ruin your reputation. Also, food was scarce at times. The average person was only one hardship away from going hungry.

Jesus had things to say about all of these dinner table issues. He would eat with anyone at any time! The religious people of the day often criticized Jesus for how and with whom he broke bread. Yet, as he became more popular, they often wanted Jesus at their tables!


