





Thank you to everyone who attended the Raft Guide Dinner Information Meeting held on Sunday, April 2nd following worship and a brief Fellowship. We are so excited about Season 11, which is just around the corner!

We provided a brief overview of the history of the Raft Guide Diners and how the original intent to provide these dinners remains a guiding light of this summer outreach. We discussed the various

financial needs of the dinners and the many ways volunteers are utilized to make the season a success.

Our next planning meeting will be on Sunday, April 16th when we hope to firm up the volunteer teams and determine how to proceed on our menu planning and meal partnerships with local restaurants. The sign-up for this dinner is on the table in Century Hall.

We are waiting the results of some preliminary granting efforts and more were discussed to approach. We are actively seeking donations and sponsorships of our Hygiene Table at \$250 per week and weekly sponsorship for the meals at the amount of \$500. Last summer we served over 645 meals to 175 different guides and 51 volunteers over the 8 weeks of dinners. These guides came to us from 38 states and 4 countries and were employed by 16 different rafting companies in our valley.. Many of the guides attended the dinners week after week and many of them had attended in previous years..

Thank you to Luke Pinneo, a raft guide himself, who approached us in 2012, about the possibility of providing a free dinner in the valley for the raft guides. And the fact that we had showers to offer made the possibility even more appealing!

Luke and his family, who live in the Pacific Northwest have remained an integral part in supporting these Raft Guide Dinner over the years and we are forever grateful.

Here is a photo of Luke and Linda Taylor in 2012 at one of the earliest dinners. After leaving the Arkansas Valley, Luke has popped in occasionally over the years and it is always a pleasure to see him and express our gratitude for what he started. He saw a need, spoke up and got involved. The rest was history....
