

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Grace and Peace in the name of Christ our Lord!

Over the past few weeks one often quoted phrase has been constantly running through my mind. "The more things change, the more they stay the same." This is a loose translation of French writer, Alphonse Karr's epigram he penned in the monthly journal Les Guêpes in January of 1849 which states, "plus ça change, plus c'est la même chose "or "the more it changes, the more it's the same thing".

I think this is true in the life of the Church. On April 15th it was announced that I am projected to be appointed to St. Luke United Methodist Church in Enterprise, Alabama. Reverend Jimmy Boone is projected to be appointed to Mount Zion. Reverend Boone has most recently served churches in Silas, Alabama. As Methodists we know that pastoral changes are part of the ministry of the Church.

However, Mount Zion's mission stays the same. It is the same mission as it was in 1831. It is the same as it was when the church moved to its current location. It is the same as it was four years ago when I had the great privilege of joining you in ministry. The church does not change. The church exists to "make disciples of Jesus Christ for the transformation of the world". As a clergy family, transition is not easy but I believe that the work of the Holy Spirit goes before all of us into whatever task is ahead.




